File Number 080645 is a resolution authorizing the City Comptroller to transfer \$10,000 from the Housing Trust Fund Special Purpose Account to a Department of Administration account for the purpose of providing funding for a study titled "A Sustainable Approach to Creating and Administering Low-Income and Special Needs Housing in Milwaukee County" to be performed by the Public Policy Forum.

Background

- 1. The Local Initiatives Support Corporation ("LISC") has requested that the City of Milwaukee provide up to \$10,000 to support an affordable housing study to be conducted by the Public Policy Forum, in cooperation with LISC.
- 2. The Public Policy Forum's proposal to LISC indicates that the total cost of this research project, which will take approximately 6 months to complete, is \$29,970.
- 3. The 2008 Budget provides \$400,000 for the Housing Trust Fund Special Purpose Account.
- 4. On August 14, 2008, the Housing Trust Fund Advisory Board approved a motion recommending the appropriation of \$10,000 from the Housing Trust Fund to fund the study proposed by LISC and the Public Policy Forum.

Discussion

- 1. This resolution authorizes the City Comptroller to transfer \$10,000 from the 2008 Housing Trust Fund Special Purpose Account to a Department of Administration account for the purpose of providing \$10,000 for the proposed study. It also authorizes DOA-Community Development Grants Administration Division to expend the transferred funds for this purpose.
- 2. The Public Policy Forum study will:
 - a. Review and analyze the existing affordable housing programs in the City of Milwaukee and Milwaukee County, including a summary of the strengths and challenges of these programs.
 - b. Review a selected group of housing trust fund and housing program administration models in other metropolitan areas, including a discussion of the potential barriers and benefits associated with replicating these models in Milwaukee.
- 3. It is anticipated that the remainder of the funds for the study -- approximately \$20,000 will be provided by LISC and Milwaukee County.

Fiscal Impact

- 1. This resolution authorizes the transfer and expenditure of \$10,000 from the 2008 Housing Trust Fund Special Purpose Account.
- 2. No other transfers or expenditures from the 2008 Housing Trust Fund Special Purpose Account have occurred this year. Therefore, adoption of this resolution will reduce the balance in the account to \$390,000.
