**WHEREAS,** *Anthony Cebar, upon receiving his degree, embarked on a career in education spanning more than three decades, teaching high school students of the Fox Point Bayside School District where he coached football and baseball, ran the A.V. club, supervised ice skating, drove school bus, and worked as a playground supervisor in the summer months; and*

**WHEREAS,** *Anthony Cebar is the beloved father of two children (and grandfather to one grandson), Paul and Mary, who he raised with his late wife, Dorothy, a remarkable woman whom he loved dearly; and*

**WHEREAS,** *Anthony Cebar has been and remains a cherished member of his community, active in his church and neighborhood, known by his friends, family, neighbors and former students for showing kindness frequently and abundantly; now, therefore, be it*
