I regret that I cannot appear before you on Wednesday, April 24, 2019, to speak personally in support of Common Council File Number 190093, resolution relative to the acceptance of funding of a Green Solutions grant from the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District of \$126,000 for the installation of a bioswales in the parking lot between South 9th Street and South 10th Street between West Lapham Boulevard and West Mitchell Street in the 12th Aldermanic District.

I have seen at first hand during my tenure on the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District's board the value the infrastructure improvements paid for by this grant have for the community.
