File # 020931 is a resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of the Wisconsin WINS Grant.

Background

- 1. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Health Department (MHD) to apply for, accept and fund the Wisconsin WINS grant project from the Wisconsin Department of Health and Family Services.
- 2. This is a new grant and will be monitored by the MHD Tobacco Prevention Manager.

Discussion

- 1. The purpose of this project is to reduce the rate at which tobacco retailers sell tobacco products to underage youth.
- 2. This grant will fund a "Recognition and Reminder" campaign focused toward retailers and clerks who sell tobacco products. The goal is to assist and reward retailers who refrain from selling tobacco products to minors.
- 3. This grant encompasses the period of October 1, 2002 through September 30, 2003.

Fiscal Impact

- 1. The total of this grant is \$67,500, entirely from the grantor.
- 2. \$60,750 (90%) of the grant is budgeted for contracts with youth-serving community organizations to assure that positive tobacco-prevention education messages are delivered to the community.
- 3. Remaining funds will be allocated for program services, supplies and outreach and education.
