Dear Alderman Kovac:

This is in response to your request on behalf of local property owners to lower the speed limit on North Downer Avenue from North Lake Drive to East Edgewood Avenue to 25 miles per hour.

Our Traffic Engineering staff has investigated this request and found the roadway segment in question has the operational characteristics of a roadway with a 25 miles per hour speed limit. Therefore, in the interest of public safety we recommend changing the 30 miles per hour speed limit on North Downer Avenue between North Lake Drive and East Edgewood Avenue to a 25 miles per hour speed limit.

We will prepare the necessary legislation that will be heard at the next Public Safety Committee meeting, so that you may support it to final passage.
