Dear Committee Members:

Attached is File No.031663, being a substitute resolution to vacate South Ferry Street between East Pittsburgh Avenue and East Seeboth Street, in the 12th Aldermanic District.

The Department of Public Works Coordinated Report contains no stated objections to the proposed vacation. The Commissioner of Public Works has requested a money deposit for the following fees:

1. Abandon combined sewer	\$ 3,000
2. Equity in 4 catch basins	\$ 1,600
3. Remove street lights	\$ 6,500
4. Street closures	\$33,200
5. Benefit Assessments	<u>\$12,185</u>
Total:	\$56,485

The petitioner has not yet made the deposit. Since the proposed vacation is not in conflict with city plans, the City Plan Commission at its regular meeting on July 12, 2004 recommended approval of the attached substitute resolution conditioned on providing the executed petition and fees.
