Dear Council Members:

The City of Milwaukee owns and operates 18"-inch and 48"-inch diameter storm sewers, 12"-inch and 21"-inch diameter sanitary sewers and 8"-inch diameter water main in North Hopkins Street, north of West Douglas Avenue. This portion of North Hopkins Street was vacated and requires quit-claiming the 18"-inch storm sewer, 12"-inch sanitary sanitary sewer and 21"-inch sanitary sewer. In addition, and easement from Milwaukee County and two licenses from the Railroad are required to protect our ability to maintain, repair, and reconstruct the 48"-inch storm sewer and 8"-inch water main.

The railroad has prepared a sewer license agreement, SL-2667B, for the 48"-inch storm sewer and a license for the water main. We have prepared an easement for the storm sewer and water main and a quit claim deed for the sanitary and storm sewers which will need to be executed by Milwaukee County.

We have prepared the attached resolution which authorizes and directs the proper City officers to execute the sewer and water license agreements and quit claim deed and accepts the sewer easement after it has been approved as to form and execution by the City Attorney.

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We recommend adoption of the resolution.
