While I acknowledge that recently Brett's Farmhouse has experienced some serious issues, I would like to appeal to the committee to not revoke our license at this time. We have been in business since 1978. Currently 8 people rely on Brett's as their main source of income. We are more than willing to revise our operational plan and make Brett's Farmhouse a safer place.

After reviewing our operation, we believe making the following changes will help to promote a safe environment:

Abbreviated hours – close early (9a.m. To 11p.m. Daily)

Add extra lighting to better illuminate the parking lot

Armed Security (9p.m. -11p.m. Thursday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday)

Metal detector - Use wand to detect concealed weapons at the door

Install “No Firearms allowed” signage

All of the above would be put in place by December 22, 2017.
