This report is written by PO Molly PLUMLEY, assigned to District One, Late Power shift. On 6/13/2018 I instructed to file this tavern report regarding an incident on 12/17/2017. I have attached a copy of Sergeant Thomas Ackley's citation narrative below.

On December 9, 2017, at about 12:30 AM, David C Robertson (W/M 11-14-1972) was operating a mobile food car, "Hot Diggity Dog." Robertson flagged me down to explain to me that an unknown person told

him that the owner of the cart owed the other unknown person \$20 and the unknown person told Robertson he should pay the \$20. While I was listening to the story, I observed that the water basin for washing hands was inoperable. There was no spigot handle and there was no catch / pipe for the water to go down into, there was just a hole at the bottom of the sink. I ordered the mobile food cart closed until the sink is fixed.

On December 17, 2017 at about 1:00 AM, I observed David Robertson operating the mobile food cart again. As I began inspection the cart, I could see there was a spigot handle attached to the spigot stem, but it just spun around. The spigot handle did not catch onto the spigot stem, and thus not turning the water faucet to an open position. No water was coming out of the spigot. I also observed a small cooking pot about 9" below the hole in the sink. As I peered directly down the sink hole, the pot would have caught about half of the water, while the other half would have fallen onto the ground. Knowing this all was a health code violation, I ordered the mobile food cart closed until it was fixed. The owner of the mobile food car, Eric ALLUMS (B/M 8-7-83), came to the scene and attempted to fix the problems. Eric Allums put a 5 gallon plastic bucket under the sink hole and advised me that is how the Health Department told him to set the waste water receptacle system up. I advised Robertson to stop selling merchandise until the cart was fixed about 3 times. While I was doing so, Robertson was snapping his tongs in my directions, singing towards me and performing Michael Jackson dances, directed at me. At about 1:45 AM, I observed Robertson sell two sausages to two customers. I observed the customers hand Robertson cash. I walked over to the food cart and advised Robertson he would be receiving a citation for failing to comply with the Police Department, as the cart was shut down for health concerns. As I issued Robertson the citation, he advised me I could shove the ticket up my ass.

This was typed with information provided by Sgt. Thomas Ackley.

Sergeant Thomas Ackley, assigned to District One, late power shift relayed the following: On Sunday, April 8, 2018, I observed a known mobile food cart operator, David Robertson cleaning a food cart up for the night. The food cart was a cart owned by Eric Allums named "hot diggity dog." The mobile food cart / trailer was operating on the sidewalk on the northeast corner of N Edison St and E Juneau Ave.

At about 2:35 am, I observed David Robertson carry a rectangular aluminum pan over to the sewer grate just south of where he was operating. I'd estimate the size of the pan was approximately a 9"x13". I've seen in the past David Robertson would use these pans as a reservoir, of sorts, to hold sausages he is keeping warm, before a customer orders an item. I observed David Robertson lean over to dump something out. I observed a liquid substance pour out of the pan and into the sewer grate. I was standing in front of 134 E Juneau Ave, Rogue's Gallery. I immediately yelled over to David Robertson, "You can't dump that out there." Robertson yelled something back, but I was unable to understand him. The owner of the cart, Eric Allums, quickly walked over to Robertson and told him to stop yelling at me. I did not interview or question Robertson due to a history of being argumentative with members of the Police Department.

On Wednesday, April 11, 2018, Kristine Vlosich, of the Milwaukee Health Department, conducted mobile food vendor training with our shift and advised us that the violation would fall under Milwaukee ordinance 68-3 and further stated that dumping liquids or solids down into the gutter is strictly prohibited.

On Thursday, April 12, I directed PO Jared Hinsenkamp and PO Gerald Kulwich to issue Robertson a citation for ordinance 68-3 when they saw him next.

I've closed them down twice now over the last two weekends, due to no water coming out of the faucet. There was also not a proper receptacle for the waste water to go into. I do not know which cart it was. From what I understand, Eric Allums still runs two carts. I issued David Robertson, AKA Superman, a citation for failure to comply with the Police, ordinance 68-41-7-j, as he was still selling hot dogs after I ordered him to close. I also attached a video of the cart. I did not have a still camera, so we used the body-worn cameras to document what they did.

While I was listening to the story, I observed that the water basin for washing hands was inoperable. 


Upon arrival I spoke to the cashier/caller, Oday Issa (W/M, 07-28-99 of 2500 W. Lisbon Avenue, PH #414-399-6195) who stated a unknown black female (who was later identified as Nakerie M. UNDERWOOD, B/F, 06-22-98) entered the store and attempted to purchase \$9.00 worth of merchandise but her quest card was declined. UNDERWOOD because angry because her card was declined and she started screaming and yelling at the cashier (Ali S. ALI, W/M, 01-09-61 of 2500 W. Lisbon Avenue, PH #414-238-7435).

UNDERWOOD pushed several boxes of candy from the counter top onto the floor. UNDERWOOD threatened to slap ISSA and ALI. UNDERWOOD threatened to have someone come up to the store, damage property, and attack both victims, causing the victims to fear for their safety.

UNDERWOOD also pushed the cash register from the counter top onto the floor, cause damage to the amount display and the internal components, without owner's consent. (value \$475). UNDERWOODS 1st and last name was on the declined receipt. ISSA searched UNDERWOOD'S name on FaceBook and found her picture. ISSA stated this was the same person involved in this incident. I searched UNDERWOOD'S name in the Milwaukee Police Department's Database and the defendant's photo, full name and date of birth came up. I compaired the FaceBook photo to the photo in the Milwaukee Police Department's database and discovered this was the same person ISSA found on FaceBook and that was the suspect in this incident. 

At approximately 9:27am POLE entered Davidson Liquor at 2900 W. Lisbon Av. She was able to purchase a flavored White Owl cigarillo from the cashier. The described cashier was identified as PATEL, Kalpeshkumar N (w/m, 06/10/1981). He stated he did check her ID but thought it showed she was 18. The licensee Kuljit SINGH was mailed a MARTS letter.

- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
