
REASON FOR REQUEST:

James Spinato, a City of Milwaukee Police Officer, was in the scope of his employment and operating a City of Milwaukee squad car that was traveling southbound on South Muskego Avenue. As the City vehicle proceeded through the intersection of South Muskego Avenue and West Rogers Street, the uninsured motorist, who was traveling westbound on West Rogers Street, failed to yield the right of way by disregarding the stop sign, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Spinato sustained a concussion and injuries to his neck, back, right knee and left elbow. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$73,182.25.
