File No. 030693 is a resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of a Wisconsin Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Funding Assistance Program grant. (Fire Department)

Background and Discussion

- This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Fire Department to apply for, accept and fund a Wisconsin Emergency Medical Services Program grant from the State of Wisconsin's Department of Health and Family Services.
- 2. The Milwaukee Fire Department provides emergency medical services to the citizens and visitors of the City.
- 3. No City contribution is required, based on the operating grant budget and fiscal note prepared by the MFD.
- 4. The total amount of the continuation grant is \$30,000.
- 5. The grant will be used to assist the Milwaukee Fire Department (an EMS provider) in enhancing the provision of emergency medical services through purchase of EMS supplies (\$5,000), equipment (\$20,000) and training (\$5,000).
- 6. The grant will be in operation from July 1, 2003 to June 30, 2004.

Fiscal Impact

The resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure of \$30,000 in grant monies according to the following purchase schedule:

- Emergency medical services supplies \$2,000.
- Paramedic Bicycle Response supplies \$3,000,
- Emergency medical equipment \$15,000,
- Paramedic Bicycle Response equipment \$5,000, and
- Education/training materials \$5,000

If the Committee does not authorize this grant, alternative funding sources, including the tax levy, would have to be considered for providing these equipment and supplies.
