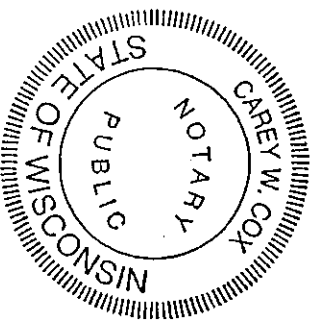

the City of Milwaukee adopted prelimi-
nary resolutions, determining it neces-
sary and in the public interest to con-
struct and levy special assessments for

driveway approaches where necessary,
sodding, grading, and tree removal
where necessary. (Grantor Paving
Non-Reimbursable Fund Milwaukee -
\$7,401,775; Grantor Paving
Non-Reimbursable Fund Wauwatosa -
\$261,905; Grantor Paving Reimbursable
Fund Milwaukee - \$1,155,520;
Non-Assessable Paving Fund -
\$629,700; Assessable Paving Fund -
\$50,000; Grantor Reimbursable Paving
Fund Wauwatosa - \$22,100). These

Resolved, By the Common Council of
the City of Milwaukee, that the Com-
missioner of Public Works Report, as
amended at said Public Hearing, is ap-
proved and the purposes therein iden-
tified are benefited; and, be it
Further Resolved, That said Commis-
sioner of Public Works is authorized
and directed to proceed with said work
in accordance with said report pursuant
to Section 66.0703 and any other perti-
nent sections of the Wisconsin Statutes
and in the manner directed by Section
115-42 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordi-
nances; and, be it
Further Resolved, That the proper
departments take such action as is re-

quired of them to assess the abutting or
adjacent properties and collect such as-
sessment in the manner directed by Sec-
tion 115-42 of the Milwaukee Code of
Ordinances; and, be it
Further Resolved, That the City
Comptroller is authorized and directed
to transfer such funds which are avail-
able for this purpose to the appropriate
capital Project/Grant accounts; and, be
it
Further Resolved, That the projects
do not involve any parcels of agricul-
tural land which are eligible for de-
ferred special assessments under the
provisions of Section 14.30 of the Mil-
waukee City Charter; and, be it
Further Resolved, That the City Engi-
neer and the Commissioner of Public
Works are hereby authorized to nego-
tiate and enter into an agreement with
the State of Wisconsin, Department of
Transportation for the City to under-
take construction management duties on
the following projects: N. 76th St. (STH
181) (ST320061001); and, be it
Further Resolved, That the City Engi-
neer is authorized and directed to op-
prove and make periodic payments to
the State of Wisconsin, Department of
Transportation after receipt of invoices
from said State for the city's share of
the costs for said projects: N. 76th St.
(STH 181) (ST320061001); and, be it
Further Resolved, That upon the
completion of projects: N. 76th St. (STH
181) (ST320061001) and W. Good Hope
Rd. (ST320071510) and a determination
of the actual costs, it is understood that
if the City of Milwaukee's share is less
than the amount previously paid, the
difference will be refunded to said City;
and, be it
Further Resolved, That the Depart-
ment of Public Works is authorized to
use the funding as specified in the
above description of work; and, be it
Further Resolved, That projects N.
76th St. (STH 181), ST320061001 and W.
Good Hope Rd. (ST320071510) will be
billed after January 1, 2011, but not be-
fore 12 months after the project con-
tract has been completed.
