Dear Alderman Murphy:

I am writing in response to your request for additional information related to Common Council File No. 090352 – A substitute charter ordinance relating to review and approval of certain city contracts at the October 28th, 2009 Finance & Personnel Committee meeting.

Based on an analysis of single and sole contracts that were awarded 2006-2008, the following contract would have been impacted by the aforementioned substitute charter ordinance.

- Description: 2007 DPW Infrastructure Services Division Vendor Service Contract for Asphalt Patch (Hot Patch)
- Original Contract Value: \$30,000
- Term: May 2007 May 2008 with two additional one year options to extend.
- Amendments: Total of 4 (Amend #1: \$170K; Amend #2: \$200K; Amend #3: \$40K; and Amend #4: \$450K)

The requests to increase the original contract amount appear to be driven by the following factors:

- 1. Underestimation of costs by the user department;
- 2. Vendor notification to the City of Milwaukee of a 10% price increase due to the rising cost of raw material which is allowable under the terms of the contract.

In short, based on a three year (2006-2008) analysis of both single and sole source contracts less than \$50K one contract out of a total of 381 contracts would have been impacted by Common Council File No. 090352 — A substitute charter ordinance relating to review and approval of certain city contracts
