

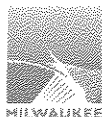

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
Dear Mr. Rogers:

This is to notify you that on Monday, October 1, 2012, the Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the Common Council that your application for a Junk Collector (Truck) license for the premises located at 3307 N. 17<sup>th</sup> St. ("D.O.C. Hauling Service") be denied. The Committee made this recommendation based on your nonappearance despite being provided timely notice of the hearing date.

On Tuesday, October 16, 2012, the Common Council considered the Committee's recommendation regarding your applications. On that date, the Common Council adopted the Committee's recommendation and denied your application for a Junk Collector (Truck) license based on your nonappearance.

If you previously paid the license fees you may be eligible for a refund, except for a portion of the fee that may be retained, by bringing in your receipt or filing an application for a refund within one year to date of Common Council action with the License Division, Room 105, City Hall.
