



HOTEL PREFERENCE

Please select 3 hotels from the list on page 11 in the order of preference. Hotel rooms will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. Reservation requests will only be accepted on the Hotel Reservation Form and must be in writing. If you prefer, you may make your reservation online at www.icsc.org/2005sc. Saturday arrivals are limited in Las Vegas. You must be registered for the 2005 ICSC Spring Convention to secure a room at a discounted rate.

DEADLINE

Hotel reservation requests must be received by DePrez Travel Bureau, Inc. in writing no later than April 12, 2005. If you have not done so by this date, your request will be processed on an availability basis.

DEPOSITS

All reservation requests must be accompanied by a valid credit card (card must expire after May 2005) or a check in the amount of \$230 (per room). Those accommodations guaranteed by the \$230 cash deposit that require additional deposit funds (i.e., suites) will be invoiced by DePrez Travel at the time of confirmation. Those accommodations guaranteed by credit card will be charged one night's room and tax as a deposit 15-45 days prior to arrival if required by the hotel. All funds, either cash or credit card charge, will be applied to your room account at the hotel.


CANCELLATIONS
