All work will be done according to the specifications and illustrations contained in this COA. Sign will be type A, individual letter with external illumination. Sign must not cover part or all of any windows or located on top of architectural details such as cornices, string courses, and decorative panels.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations. 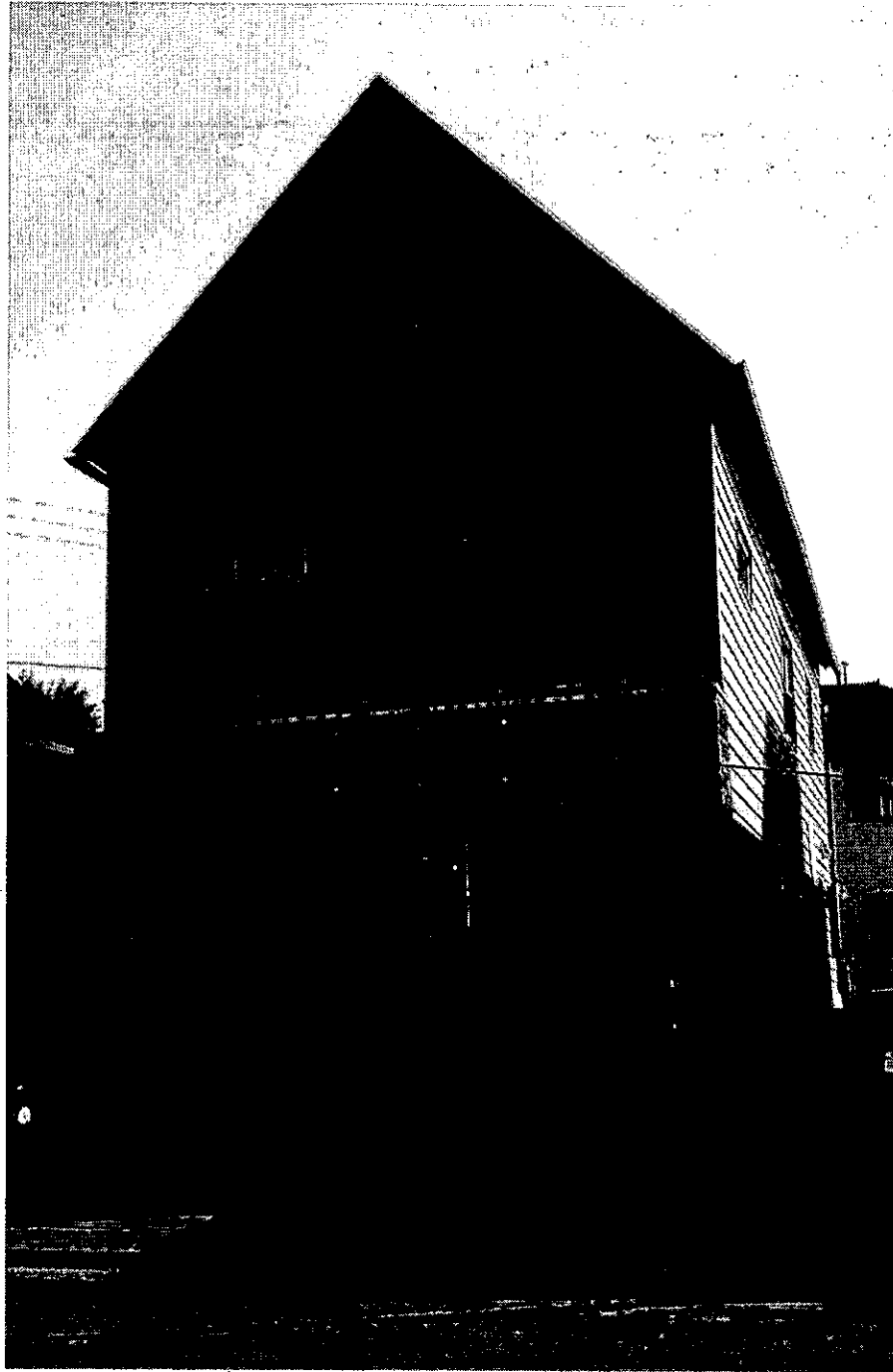
