This report is written by Police Officer Carlos Felix, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 08/24/23 at 12:20a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery at 5100 W Howard Ave. investigation revealed the victim called the police from the establishment, however, it did not occur there.

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2. On 08/11/24 at 3:06a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Subject with a Gun at 5100 W. Howard Ave. Officers were advised a subject that had been on the premise earlier, who the bartender was told had a firearm, was pounding on the door refusing to leave. The officer located the subject, who was found to be unarmed. The subject was conveyed to their residence.

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The following items are related to Merry's located at 5100 W. Howard Ave.

3. On 04/20/25, at 4:56 a.m., officers were dispatched to a Threat complaint. The caller stated they were kicked out of the business for unknown reasons and when they attempted to reenter to get their cigarettes an employee threatened to shoot them. An employee informed officers the caller was kicked out after making other customers feel uncomfortable and then attempted to enter after the establishment was close.

4. On 05/18/25, at 1:25 a.m., Milwaukee Police received a Fight complaint. A group of 10 to 20 people including employees engaged in a physical fight outside of the business. An employee on scene did not cooperate when officers requested to review security camera footage. Additional follow up was done and the footage was provided.
5. On 10/04/25, at 12:44 a.m., an officer was dispatched to a Battery complaint. The caller left prior to the officer's arrival. An employee stated there was a fight in the business which spilled outside but the actors were no longer on scene. Security camera footage was not available at the time of the investigation.
6. On 01/19/26, at 12:19 a.m., an officer was dispatched to a Trouble with Subject complaint. A bartender stated the caller was upset because they were cut off, but they left prior to the officer's arrival. No business violations observed.

This report is being written by PO John LOPEZ assigned to District 6, Late shift, Squad 6320. On April 20th 2025 at 4:56, I and PO PARKS were dispatched to a threat complaint at 5100 W Howard Ave (Merrys), which is in the City and County of Milwaukee.

Upon Arrival I saw a man, Later Identified as Eddie A. RICKETTS (W/M 12/07/1989) standing across of the bar, Merrys. RICKETTS approached us and stated he was the caller. RICKETTS stated that he was patroning Merry's was kicked out at approximately 2:30AM from the bar after talking to some females. RICKETTS stated that he does not know the reason why he was told to leave. RICKETTS stated that he went for a walk and later remembered that he forgot his cigarettes at and went back to Merry's and tried to open the door of the establishment. RICKETTS stated he was told he was going to get shot if he did not leave the premise. RICKETTS stated he did not want to press charges. While I was speaking to RICKETTS, I observed that he was impaired by intoxicates.

PO PARKS spoke with the bartender, Thomas P. CONDECOU (W/M 07/24/1997), on scene. CONDECOU stated that RICKETTS was talking to the female patrons of the bar and was making them feel uncomfortable. CONDECOU stated that at 2:32 was asked to leave the bar. CONDECOU stated that RICKETTS was surveilling the bar and caused the females to be uncomfortable to leave the bar. CONDECOU stated as a result, the females asked to be escorted to their cars. CONDECOU stated that after the females left, RICKETTS was pulling on the handle of the bar attempting to gain entry into the bar after it has been closed.

CONDECOU stated that RICKETS was banned from coming back to the establishment.

On Sunday, May 18, 2025, squad 6320, squad 6330 and squad 6390 (P.O. GONZALEZ/ P.O. CONNER/P.O. WOPPERT/ P.O. DELANEY) were dispatched to the address of 5100 W Howard Ave, Merry's Bar. Which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI regarding a Bar fight.

Upon arrival, all parties were outside in the parking lot screaming. The bartender of Merry's Bar, Thomas PERCIVAL (W/M 07-24-1997) (414) 543-0500, was outside screaming at everyone even the police officers that arrived on scene first. PERCIVAL was outside in the parking lot screaming "FUCK this place, fuck this job I'm taking my tips and leaving". As more police officers arrived on scene, we were able to control the scene and calm everyone down. P.O. WOPPERT was outside with the victim Milo ESPARAPANIA (B/M 10-15-1998), (414)-801-9432, who was bleeding from his right side of his face from having a glass cup smashed on him, from another patron of the bar. The cut on ESPARAPANIA face was at least 1 inch in length and required stitches. ESPARAPANIA was conveyed via ambulance from the scene to Ascension Wisconsin Hospital for his injuries.

I spoke to the caller, PERCIVAL who stated that he called police due to a party of 10 people men and female, who started to accuse patrons of the bar of stealing one of their friend's cell phones. That is when a bar fight broke out between 10-20 people including the bartender of Merry's Bar. After everyone was separated it was founded out that, someone from the party of 10 had the cellphone the entire time.

I asked numerous times, and the bartender PERCIVAL was not very cooperative with the police regarding being able to see their surveillance. I attempted to follow-up with the bar regarding the surveillance footage and was able to speak to Nick BRANDT (W/M 05-10-1991), the person in charge of the surveillance footage. I was able to view the footage of the incident and I sent an evidence.com link to BRANDT so footage could be uploaded. BRANDT was very cooperative with showing me footage of the bar fight.

While on scene, I observed the licenses posted and they were up to date with effective date until 05/07/2026.

Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

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## Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
  - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
  - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
  - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
  - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.


