# 234 - BATTERY

During Det. SCHMITZ' interview, she indicated that both Officer YOUNG and TRIGG "had attitude problems with each other." She stated that although she told Officer YOUNG the name wasn't necessary, "he persisted in bantering with TRIGG."

TRIGG's mother and father appeared at the door and gave the investigators TRIGG's information, but Officer YOUNG was not satisfied, stating he "wanted to hear it from him (TRIGG)." Based on the lack of cooperation from TRIGG, Officer YOUNG called for backup officers to meet him. When officers arrived, they arrested TRIGG based on "following the lead of Officer YOUNG."

TRIGG was arrested for State Disorderly Conduct and Resisting an Officer. The matter was reviewed at the District Attorney's Office by A.D.A. Michael MAHONEY, who declined to issue criminal charges against TRIGG.

## **CONCLUSION:**

TRIGG reported this matter to the Internal Affairs Division because he believe's Officer YOUNG falsified the arrest reports and he should never have been arrested.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy District Attorney Jon REDDIN, with TRIGG present during the conference. D.D.A. REDDIN declined to issue criminal charges against Officer YOUNG adding, "while this incident should never have gotten to the step it did, nothing criminal occurred."

This matter has been referred to I.A.D. Personnel Unit for investigation into possible departmental rule violations. Criminal investigation is complete.
