


- 1. Call to Order

City of Milwaukee Business Improvement District 19 Board Member Nominations



Milwaukee BID 19 will be accepting nominations for board members during our annual meeting scheduled for October 8, 2015 at 5PM

The Board's primary responsibility is to implement this Operating Plan. This will require the Board to negotiate with providers of services and materials to carry out the Plan; to enter various contracts; to monitor development activity; to periodically revise the Operating Plan; to ensure District compliance with the provisions of applicable statues and regulations; and to make reimbursements for any overpayments of the BID assessments.,

State law requires that the Board be composed of at least five (5) members and that a majority of the

Board members be owners or occupants of property within the District.

It is recommended that the BID board be structured and operated as follows:

- 1. Board Size Thirteen (13)
- ** The Board operates under a "GO FORWARD" attitude. Therefore, we have business owners that are waiting aggressively to be a part of such a wonderful change focused board. **
- 2. Composition- At least seven members or a majority of the board (whichever is smaller) are owners or operators of property within the District. Any non-owners or operators appointed to the Board shall be a resident of the City of Milwaukee. The Board will elect its President from among its members
- 3. Term- Appointments to the Board will be for a period of three years
- 4. Compensation- None
- 5. Meeting- All meeting of the Board will be governed by the Wisconsin Open Meetings Law.
- 6. Record Keeping- Files and records of the Board's affairs will be kept pursuant to public record requirement.
- 7. Staffing- the Board may employ staff and/or contract for staffing services pursuant to this Plan and subsequent modifications thereof.
- 8. Meetings- The Board will meet regularly, at least twice (2) a year. The Board will adopt rules of order (bylaws) to govern the conduct of its meetings if none are in place.

In addition to item 2, listed above, Board members must not be delinquent with their City of Milwaukee property taxes or have any code violations on their property.

We are also asking that each Board Member be willing to dedicate at least four (4) hours sper month to conducting the business of the BID (i.e. meetings, responding to emails, reading reports, etc.)
