Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

Milwaukee police are investigating a shooting on the city's north side that left three people injured early Saturday

morning, December 22,2024

The shooting occurred about 3 a.m. at the 3400 block of North Holton Street, police said.

The victims are a 16-year-old who was shot on the side, a 49-year-old who was shot multiple times to the body and a 29-year-old. All the wounds are non-life threatening, police said.

Police are investigating what led up to the shooting and are seeking a suspect or suspects.

MILWAUKEE — A 44-year-old died in a shooting Sunday night near N. Holton St. and W. Center St. at about 7:45 p.m., according to the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD).

The Milwaukee Fire Department (MFD) responded to the shooting at about 7:50 p.m. and took them to a local hospital for treatment.

At the scene, TMJ4 News crews saw Milwaukee Police officers canvassing the area for evidence. A portion of Holton Street was blocked off by Police Sunday night during the investigation. It is unclear what led up to the shooting.

This report is written by Police Officer Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. INCIDENT: On 02/11/95 at about 1:45AM one Corey Pittman was in the process of exiting the Ret Lounge located at 3400 N. Holton when he got into a confrontation with patrons who were entering the tavern. Mr. Pittman was shot at least 6 times, and died on the sidewalk in front of the tavern. At least 23 shots were fired at pittman and a friend.
- 2. INCIDENT: On 08/17/96 at 2:30AM Officers were dispatched to the Ret Lounge located at 3400 N. Holton St. for shots fired. Officers spoke to the bar manager who stated that she had a problem with a customer but he left. She did say that she had heard two shots from outside in front of the tavern but she did not see anything.
- 3. INCIDENT: On 09/01/96 at 2:39AM Officers were dispatched to the Ret Lounge located at 3400 N. Holton St. for a shooting. Officers found two subjects inside the tavern that had been shot. Investigation revealed that the two subjects had been in the Ret Lounge and left at closing, and were shot while standing in front of the tavern. Two of the projectiles had penetrated into the wall of the tavern.
- 4. INCIDENT: On 01/05/97 at 2:20AM Officers were flagged down by a citizen regarding a Battery complaint which occurred at the Ret Lounge located at 3400 N. Holton St. The victim stated that two of her friends got into an argument inside the tavern, and turned on her hitting her in the head with a beer bottle, biting her on the arm, and beat her about her face and body. The suspects were arrested for Battery.

- 5. On 11/12/98 the applicant was issued a citation for failing to pay for his 1998/1999 food license for 3400 N. Holton St. The case was dismissed.
- 6. INCIDENT: On 05/14/00 at about 1:59AM Officers were dispatched to investigate a report of shots fired call from 3423 N. Buffum St. Upon the Officers arrival Officers found several bullet casings in front of the Ret's Lounge located at 3400 N. Holton St. Upon interviewing the bartender of the tayern, she stated that after the tayern closed she heard shots fired outside of the tayern. No one observed the person who fired the shots. Officers did recover 34 casings from the area. No one from the tavern called the Police. Criminal Complaint filed.
- 7. INCIDENT . On 2-3-2001, an anonymous citizen reported that a man was pistol whipped at the Rhett Lounge, 3400 N Holton Street. The caller hinted that the actors were gang members. Investigating officers confirmed that the incident had occurred. Three males with handguns attacked the victim. The bartender stated she threatened to call the police to stop the suspects hitting the victim, but she never called. Once the incident was over the victim related that he did not need an ambulance and asked that the police not be called. The reason was that he was on parole, and feared that having police contacted would violate his parole. The victim was beaten because he made it known that he no longer wanted to be in the gang, and he was confronted by at least six Vice Lord gang members, while at the Rhett Lounge. The suspects were identified, and are all members of the Vice Lord street gang. The incident is currently under review by the District Attorney's office and a disposition is pending.
- 8. INCIDENT On 2-20-03, at 8:00PM, Milwaukee Police were sent to Rhett Lounge, 3400 N Holton Street, to check for a man wanted for robbery. Upon arrival, police found the suspect sitting at a table. From the suspect's jacket, officers discovered a Glock pistol that was later discovered to be stolen. Also observed seated at the bar was another male who appeared young. Upon checking, he was found to be 19 years old. The licensed bartender, Annie D Reed, was given a verbal warning and the licensee, LC Whitehead was advised.

The following Citations issued to Anthony Whitehead, who is an officer.

9. On 2-16-04, officers on routine patrol in the 2500 block of N 5th Street, observed two subjects exit the side door of the Met Tavern, 541 W Clarke Street, and one subject identified as Anthony Whitehead standing in the doorway. Upon seeing the officers, Whitehead sent several people to an adjacent room, which was attached to the tavern. After approximately 2 minutes, Whitehead let the officers enter the tavern. Upon entering the officers observed numerous bottles of beer, shot glasses, and glasses with mixed drinks on the main bar and jackets on the stools in front of the drinks. Four patrons were found hiding on the second floor of the premises.

10. On 3-5-04, at 9:21AM, officers responded to a report of a Subject with a gun, 2119 W Clarke Street. On arrival the found the applicant standing on a porch, having an argument with two other persons. The argument was loud, involved swearing and yelling, and continued even though officers requested the parties involved to calm down. At one point the applicant threw down his jacket, and took off his jewelry, and was going to fight the other parties on the sidewalk. No gun was found; the applicant had a Polaroid camera in a camera bag, which he reached into at times. The applicant was cited for Disorderly Conduct. THE CASE WAS DISMISSED IN Municipal Court on 05/19/2004

14. On 06/08/08 at 1:44 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 3400 N Holton Street for a Battery/Cutting complaint. Officers spoke to Anthony Whitehead who stated a known patron stabbed him after he gave her money for some plumbing work he was do to for her. Whitehead then stated the patron "flipped out" and pulled out a knife and started to come after him. Whitehead stated that he was able to get the knife away. While officers were interviewing Whitehead, they were advised by dispatch that the suspect of the stabbing called and officers were given the location of where the suspect was. Officers changed locations to where the suspect was and spoke to her.

15. The suspect then stated to officers that she and Whitehead were arguing about the money she gave him to fix her roof and refrigerator. The suspect stated Whitehead then slammed down some money on her table stating, "Here's your fucking money" and then pushed her to the ground breaking her glasses. She further stated she then grabbed a knife that was on her table because she was alone and had to look after her self. Officers arrested the suspect and charged her with battery while armed. The case was reviewed by the DA's office and no charges were issued.

- 19. On 09/01/2016 officer received a complaint of after hours parties at RET Lounge, 3400 N. Holton St. The officers went to the establishment and spoke with the bartender Annie REED. She stated the bar does have parties every other Friday but they do not go after hours and she has not observed any marijuana sales. The officer informed her they would be checking the bar more frequently.
- 20. On 03/31/2019 at 9:33pm officers observed a motorcycle parked on the sidewalk in front of Ret Lounge, 3400 N. Holton St, which is home to a motorcycle group. The officer located the owner and had him properly park it on the street. The officers then conducted a tavern check and spoke with Betty WHITEHEAD, the wife of the agent. She stated there were no problems at the tavern.
- 21. On 03/31/2019 at 10:26pm officers were dispatched to a shots fired complaint at Ret Lounge, 3400 N. Holton St. The caller stated there was an argument and subjects were shooting at his car, which caused him to flee striking a pedestrian. While on scene the caller returned and spoke with the officers. He stated he was inside Ret Lounge and was attempting to use the bathroom. He was told by a member of a motorcycle club that he could not use the bathroom because the club president was using it. An argument ensued and the caller decided to leave. Outside he stated he heard 5 gunshots and he fled in his auto and he was unsure if he struck someone. The officer did not find evidence of shots fired. The bartender, Betty McKNIGHT-WHITEHEAD, stated they did have cameras but she was unsure how to operate them. The officer was able to view the video but determined the low quality picture would not be useful to the investigation.

22. On 04/21/2019 at 1:48am officers were dispatched to Shots Fired outside of Ret Lounge with 50 to 70 people fighting. When the officers arrived they stopped a subject getting into a car and found him to be in possession of a handgun. During a Mirandized interview the subject stated there was an argument involving his wife's friend and the bar owner. The fight became physical between the wife's friend and the owners sister. The fight moved outside where someone yelled that "They had a gun". Believing the other side had a gun the subject's wife grabbed her gun from her purse. The subject grabbed the gun from his wife because he knows the owner is former military and would shoot if he saw a firearm. At 7:47pm the officer went to the bar to see the surveillance video to determine what happened that morning. The staff stated they did not want to look at the video while the bar was open, so the officer should return at a different time. The officers returned on 04/28/2019 and were advised the video is only saved for 4 days so the video from the incident had been deleted.

23. On 02/24/24 at 12:11a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Fight of approximately 30 people at the intersection of N. Holton and E. Townsend. On arrival officers did not observe anyone fighting. Due to the nature of the assignment officers conducted a License Premise Check of 3400 N. Holton. It appeared the bar was getting ready to close for the evening. Officers interviewed the bartender who stated they did not know if there was a fight outside.

24. On 03/01/25 at 2:06a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Welfare of Citizen at 3400 N. Holton. Investigation revealed a disabled subject was at the business drinking with friends, however, they left them. The officers conveyed the subject to a residence.

This report is written by Police Officer Luis MENDOZA, assigned to District Five, Late Power Shift

On March 1st, 2025, P.O. Kyle LABENSKY and I, were assigned to squad 5428 (Tavern squad). We were both in full duty uniform, operating a marked Milwaukee Police Department squad, and equipped with Axon body worn cameras.

The caller, who was verbally identified as Cyril GAMBLE (m/b, 8-2-73) stated a patron was at the location unable to move on their own. GAMBLE stated the patron was using a walker and described him as dead weight.

Upon arrival, we entered the business and observed Bell 413 talking to an individual later identified as Andrew A DAVIS (m/b, 12-21-84), who is a paraplegic. DAVIS was sitting on the floor next a walker. Bell advised us that DAVIS refused to go to the hospital. Bell left the location and P.O. LABENSKY interviewed DAVIS while I spoke to GAMBLE.

GAMBLE stated he observed DAVIS arrive to the bar with a group of individuals. GAMBLE stated DAVIS only had a few drinks and was being assisted by his friends. GAMBLE stated at bar close, the group left DAVIS by himself at the bar.

GAMBLE stated the business has functional surveillance cameras but only the owner

has access to them. GAMBLE showed me the license's to the business which were valid.

During the investigation, it was determined no crime was committed.

P.O. LABANSKY and I assisted DAVIS into our squad car and conveyed him to his mothers house located at 3263 N Buffum St where he was let inside.

GAMNLE was cooperative for the entirety of the investigation.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
