In accordance with the provisions of Section 320-21 (11) and (12) of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, the Milwaukee Historic Preservation Commission has issued a certificate of appropriateness for the work listed above. The work was found to be consistent with preservation guidelines. The following conditions apply to this certificate of appropriateness:

The new pool will measure 40' x 20'. The new masonry piers for the steel fence must match he original piers in terms of brick color texture and size and must match the original mortar on the house in terms of color, texture, joint width and joint finish. A stone tile patio will border the pool and a wood privacy fence will screen the pool from the neighbors to the west and south.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations.
