

Dear Mr. Brown:

This office is in receipt of your claim in the amount of \$1,524.97, relating to damage sustained to your vehicle when tree limbs fell on it at 2654 North 46th Street.

The Forestry Division records indicate they responded to a service request on August 17, 2001. At that time, a broken branch and some larger dead wood was removed. The evaluation completed at that time determined removal was not required. The Division received two additional service requests regarding this tree. On September 7, 2001 another evaluation was completed and the decision was a made to remove the tree. The tree was removed on or about September 12, 2001. The division followed standard and customary procedures and as such, the City cannot accept liability for your loss. Accordingly, we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a letter within 21 days of the receipt of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202, requesting a hearing.
