

This report is written by Police Officer David NOVAK, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 02/08/2014 at 2:31am Officers responded to St. Joseph's Hospital for a shooting call. The investigation revealed that the victim and some friends were leaving the Ace High bar at 2928 W. Lisbon Ave at about 2:25am. The victim got into the front passenger seat of his Cadillac Escalade. As the truck was pulling off an unknown subject, who had also just exited the bar, walked up to the Cadillac and fired a shot into the front passenger door striking the victim in the right hip. The driver of the Cadillac pulled off and drove the victim to the Hospital. Further investigation revealed after the victim left, the suspect ran to a vehicle and a different suspect appeared to fire a handgun at the first suspect while he was in his auto. The first subject fled in his auto and the second suspect fled on foot. There were 19 casing recovered scattered in the street. The applicant was contacted on 02/09/2014. She stated that she was at the bar when the shooting occurred. She was advised at the time by her security who heard the shots outside. She stated she got on the floor during the shots and only looked outside after the shoots stopped. She did not see the incident. She stated that there were no altercations inside the bar prior to closing. The camera footage from the bar was copied and placed on inventory.

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2. On 02/15/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a shot spotter call in the area of North 30th Street and West Lisbon Avenue. Officers discovered two parked vehicles with damage that appeared to be from gunshots. Derrick Dunlap, who identified himself as the owner of Aces High, told officers gunshots were heard shortly after two subjects were refused entry to the club. Officers did not locate any witness's to this incident. Milwaukee police incident report #150460009 filed.

This report is a summary of reports written by P.O. Daniel DREWEK and P.O. Markel MCKINLEY.

On Sunday, February 15, 2015 at 1:15am, Squad 3390 (P.O. Daniel DREWEK and P.O. Markel MCKINLEY), was dispatched to a shots spotter call for 30th and Lisbon Ave. Upon arrival, Officers located 2 vehicles parked at 30th and Lisbon Ave that had been shot into. One vehicle had an apparent bullet hole to the front windshield and the second had damage to the front drivers and passenger windows. Do to the position of parked vehicles it appeared the shots were fired from the North.

P.O. DREWEK spoke with Aces High owner Derrick J. DUNLAP (b/m, 05/10/67), and Security Guard Timothy D. BENNET (b/m, 08-18-86). Who stated 2 individuals approximately 26-27 years of age had been turned away from the front door, because the premise was at capacity. BENNET stated the subjects were upset about not being admitted and the subject walked northbound. Shortly after the subjects walked away gunshots were heard. Patrons in the premise dived for cover inside the premise after hearing the shots being fired. No one observed who fired the shots or saw the vehicles being struck.

Video surveillance from the premise was observed and showed two males subjects standing by the front door outside the premise and begin to walk north bound on 30th St. One subject jumps a snow bank to get on a sidewalk, the other subject runs towards a vehicle parked on the east side of 30th St. Recovered at approximately the same location the subjects are seen getting into the vehicle 1816 N. 30th St. 6 spent 45acp casings and 1 unfired 45acp cartridge were recovered.

No calls for Shots fired were made, only reports of shots being fired came from shot spotter (3000 W. Lisbon Ave and 2925 W. Lisbon Ave.)
