### Professional Biography

Stormy M. Walker holds an Associate in Political Science from Parkland Community College in Champagne, Illinois. Since July, 1996, she has served as the Executive Vice President of the Milwaukee Women's Center, Inc. (MWC), a women and minority governed and operated, non-profit, social service. The Center provides a shelter for battered women and children, facilities and outpatient services for mental health and substance abuse. Previously, Ms. Walker was the Director of MWC's POWER (Positive Options for Women Entering Recovery) Program, a nationally recognized program for substance abusing women and families.

Prior to MWC, Ms. Walker worked for 12 years at The Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office as a Sexual Assault Counselor for the first juvenile victim/witness program in the country. She interviewed and counseled sexual assault victims and determined their ability to testify. Ms. Walker's expertise in dealing with adolescents has benefited hundreds of teens and their families.

Ms. Walker's expertise is in non-profit leadership, administration, team building, case management, family/intimate violence, substance abuse, mental health, counseling and assisting sexual assault victims, program development and implementation. She is a nationally recognized trainer and presenter in the areas of sexual assault, family violence, women and family issues, diversity in the workplace, and ethical leadership in non-profits.

Ms. Walker is a member of the Black Health Coalition, Fetal Infant Morality Review Board, Governor's Council on Domestic Violence, and the Mayor's Crime Commission.
