File #001783 is a resolution relative to the application, acceptance and funding of the STD/HIV Prevention Training Grant by the Health Department.

Background and Discussion

- 1. This resolution authorizes the Health Department to accept and fund the STD/HIV Prevention Training Grant project from the Centers for Disease Control through the Cincinnati Health Department. This is a continuation grant.
- 2. The purpose of the grant is for the Health Department STD Clinic to serve as a model training center for students and professionals enrolled in the STD/HIV Prevention Training Center of Cincinnati.
- 3. The Cincinnati STD/HIV Prevention Training Center is one of 10 regional sites participating in a national network to provide effective training in STD clinical services. The Cincinnati regional site serves Indiana, Illinois, Michigan, Minnesota, Ohio and Wisconsin. The Centers for Disease Control sponsors this disease prevention effort in cooperation with health departments and medical schools which provide staff for didactic, clinical, administrative and research areas.
- 4. The Health Department STD program and Central Health Clinic (CHC) provides comprehensive diagnosis, treatment and case management to STD clients and offers HIV testing for all clients. In partnership with the Cincinnati STD/HIV Prevention Training Center, the clinic has the experience, expertise and facility for learning opportunities and training through:
 - A state-of-the-art Central Health Clinic with on-site diagnostic laboratory for examinations, tests, diagnosis, treatment and follow-up.
 - Cultures processed at the regional public health reference laboratory.
 - Computerized medical information management system to handle clinical records and reporting.

Fiscal Impact

- 1. The total for the STD/HIV Prevention Training Grant is \$40,756 in funding, entirely from the grantor. There is no City in-kind share.
- 2. The grant funds one position, Nurse Practitioner (.5 FTE), SG670. The balance of the funding will be used for supplies, materials and services.
- 3. The grant period is from April 1, 2001 through March 31, 2002.
