
Dear Mr. Lucas:

You are hereby notified that the Milwaukee Common Council will hold a hearing on February 10, 2004 commencing at 9:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as this matter may be heard, in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202 to consider your renewal application for the Class "A" Liquor and Malt license for the premises located at 3426 West Lisbon Avenue, Milwaukee, Wisconsin ("Lisbon Liquor").

Attached you will find a copy of the Report of the Utilities and Licenses Committee which includes their Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendation, recommending nonrenewal of the Class "A" Liquor and Malt license for the premises located at 3426 West Lisbon Avenue in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin ("Lisbon Liquor"). The recommendation is the result of a public hearing before the Committee held on January 27, 2004 and based upon your non-appearance and the provisions of s. 90-11-1-b, Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.

You may file a written objection to the Report of the Utilities and Licenses Committee and shall have the opportunity to present arguments in writing supporting that objection to the Common Council. Any written objections to the Committee's Report must be filed with the City Clerk at least two (2) days prior to the above-mentioned date set for hearing by the Common Council. You or a legal representative may also appear at the Common Council meeting and request an opportunity to address the Common Council for approximately five (5) minutes to present an oral argument on your own behalf.
