Regarding: Your Food Dealer Retail Application for "Your Family Store" at 3251 N 9TH St.

There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Limited parking for persons attending meetings in City Hall is available at reduced rates (5 hour limit) at the Milwaukee Center on the southwest corner of East Kilbourn and North Water Street. Parking tickets must be validated in the first floor information booth in City Hall.

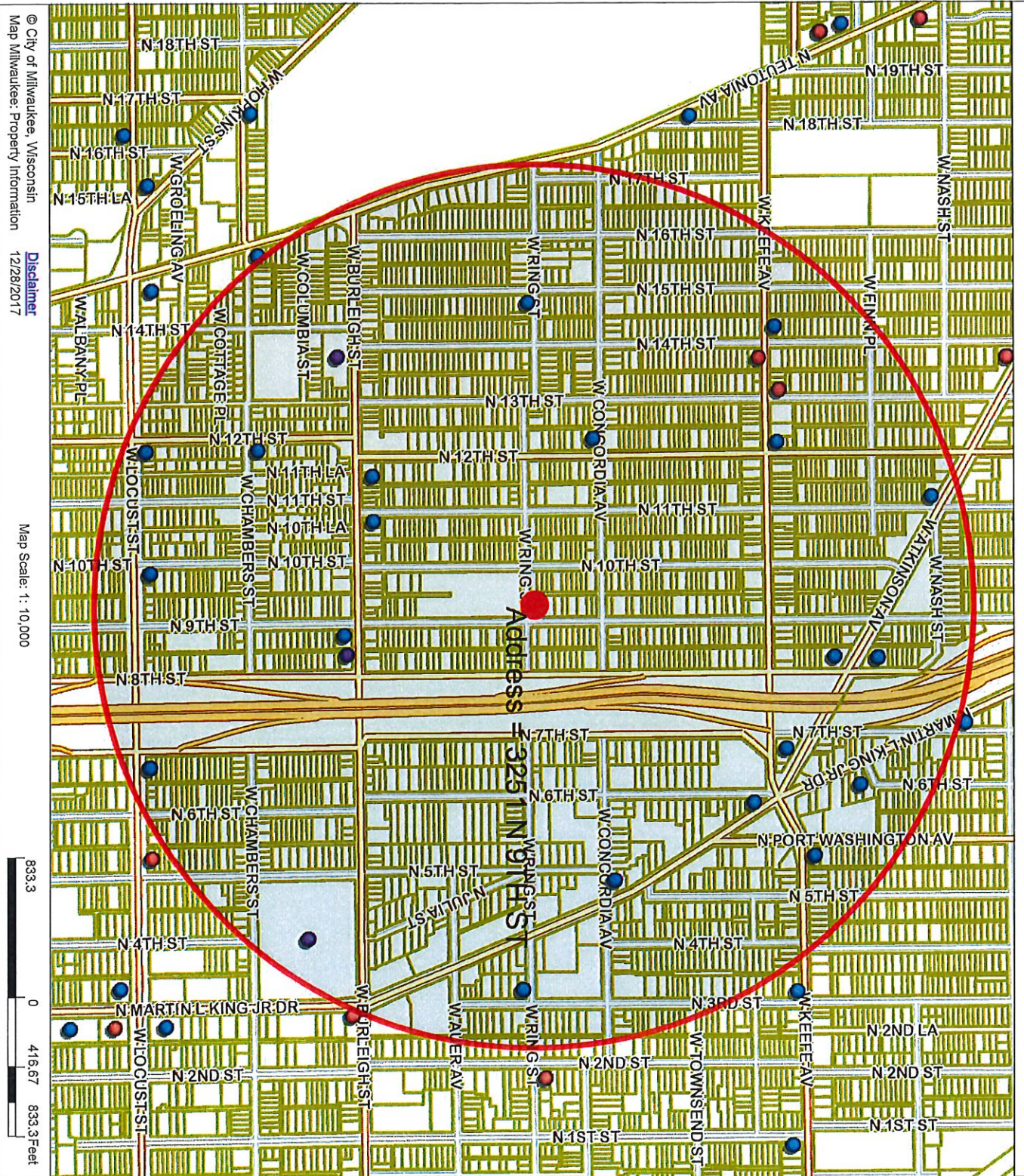

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 1/3/2018 at 10:00 AM, in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

Good Afternoon,

My name is Jennifer Gorecki and I am a Service Coordinator for St. Clare Management, Inc. We manage Clare Central Apartments located at 1003/1033 W. Atkinson Ave. This is directly across from 1101 W. Atkinson Ave. The apartments here are HUD subsidized independent apartments for low income people with physical disabilities. We have met with Alderwoman Coggs in the past to let her know our concerns regarding this neighborhood area and the presence of the liquor store (1101 W. Atkinson) there.

Our previous concerns continue:

- 1) Loitering on the corner area of 11th and Atkinson (both sides of 11th St).
- 2) Littering of bottles, cans and other debris purchased at the liquor store on our property
- 3) Loitering and public drinking on our property from customers of the liquor store despite us having District 5 No Loitering signs and a standing complaint with District 5 to enforce the no loitering.

We do understand that it is difficult to control the behavior of people in a neighborhood but we hope that the owner of 1101 W. Atkinson Ave. will try his best to minimize any impact that his customers and

his establishment have on the neighborhood. We regularly attend the monthly Crime and Safety meetings for Police District 5 and try to attend Alderwoman Coggs Town Hall Meetings when we can and we hope that he would do those things as well. We have met with the Community Liaison Officers at District 5 for Security Assessments and have implemented their suggestions on how to improve our property including cutting down a tree that stood near the corner of 11th and Atkinson that unfortunately was used as a shady area to loiter, and adding better and additional security lighting. Perhaps that is something he could do as well.

There is one other concern that came to our attention from the last licensing hearing. I watched the replay of the hearing and a Melvin Mack testified in favor of 1101 W. Atkinson as an employee of the business. He stated that he lived at 1033 W. Atkinson Ave, Apt. #6. Melvin Mack is not a tenant of ours. He has actually been banned from the entire property of 1033 W. Atkinson since August of 2013. We banned him from the property due to an assault that happened in the hallways of the building and was caught on camera. He is related to a tenant at the building. He is still currently banned from the property and this is posted at the building and has been shared with Police District 5. I did contact Alderwoman Coggs and the City Clerk License Division when I noticed this and sent emails and the posting of his being banned to them. I was told that this would be noted for future hearings and I wanted to remind you of this before this new hearing. Those who testify take an oath to tell the truth so he was lying under oath in his testimony at the last hearing. I have attached the original emails and the banned listing for your reference.

We are unable to attend the license hearing on 1-3-18. We would like to work with all neighbors, businesses, and community partners in 2018 to try to make this neighborhood a safer and healthier place to live and work. We are very concerned about all of the violence and criminal activity in this area-just today someone was shot on the 3600 block of north 11st street near the corner of 11th and Atkinson and we are working with the police so that they could view our security cameras for their investigation. There is a lot of drug activity that takes place on north 11st street out of vehicles. There have been many shootings and homicides near this corner and we hope that the owner of 1101 W. Atkinson is working on ways that he and his business can help to make this a safer place as well. Please contact us at 385-5330 if you have any questions.

I watched the replay of the testimony regarding this license again (1-5-16) and I observed that one of the people testifying in favor of this license was Melvin Mack (the 1st person to testify in favor) and he stated that he lives at 1033 W. Atkinson Ave, #6. This is NOT true, in fact we have banned him from our property since August of 2013. He was banned for assaulting someone on camera on our property. His sister lives at the address he testified to and she is aware he is banned and the list of people banned from the property was last updated on 10-14-2015. I did check with our maintenance staff to make sure that he has not been around the property lately and I was told that they believe he actually lives at 1114 W. Atkinson (where another one of his family lives).

The attachment to this email is a copy of the notices that were posted on all apartment doors at the building (and given to District 5 liaison officers) regarding Mr. Mack not being allowed on the property. I understand that this will probably not make a difference in the outcome of this hearing but I do want to fully report that this testimony given under oath was false. Mr. Melvin stated he was also an employee of the business and that he helps to escort people home if they need this. Lying under oath should not be tolerated and I hope that the licensing committee takes whatever actions they can regarding this information.

I called the 286-City number to find out if this information should be reported somewhere and they told me to call, 286-2238 the City Clerk License Division so I will also do that.

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
