REASON FOR REQUEST:

Troy Johnson, a City of Milwaukee police detective, was in the scope of his employment and a passenger in a City of Milwaukee police squad car that was traveling westbound on West Hampton Avenue with its emergency lights and siren activated. As the City vehicle entered the intersection of West Hampton Avenue and North 54th Street, a phantom vehicle, which was proceeding southbound on North 54th Street, failed to yield the right-of-way by disregarding the stop sign, causing the City vehicle to swerve and crash into a series of parked cars. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Detective Johnson sustained injuries to his head, neck, and right knee. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$3,564.56.
