This proposal enables us to provide services to the populations that are most impacted by STIs, which is Milwaukee's Black Community and other communities of color who are disproportionatley implacted by rates of STIs. This grant helps us reach patients in the community who may not have access to a Health Center for testing.





4. Describe any engagement efforts with minority communities potentially impacted by the proposal.

This proposal serves the communites most impacted by STIs and affords staff the opportunity to engage with clients both at the Health Center and in the community where they reside. This proposal supports testing, education and prevention activies in community spaces to reach those most impacted by the STI rates.

5. Describe how any anticipated equity impacts of the proposal will be documented or evaluated.

The Disease investigation segement of the Sexual and Reproductive Health Program at MHD documents client demographics for all disease investigations and follow-up. Keenan program staff working in tandem with the State (DHS) to prioritze cases based on client demographics, such as age or evaluated conditions. The demographics are montitored byt he state and progress is continously evaulated based on the timeliness of response, adequacy of follow-up and epidemoioligic surveillance.

6. Describe strategies that will be used, if any, to mitigate any anticipated equity impacts.

The proposal supports equity by serving the population most impacted by STIs, which is Milwaukee's Black Community.
