PROHIBITION OF TURNS ON RED
WESTBOUND ON WEST CAPITOL DRIVE AT
WEST ATKINSON AVENUE/NORTH 19TH PLACE

Dear Alderman Hamilton and Alderwoman Coggs:

Westbound vehicles on West Capitol Drive turning right on red onto West Atkinson Avenue must cross North 19th Place, creating an unsafe situation. To ensure safe operation of the traffic signals, we recommend the installation of signs prohibiting turns on red westbound on West Capitol Drive at West Atkinson Avenue/North 19th Place.
