2nd Aldermanic District

W. Medford Ave. – W. Hampton Ave. to W. Grantosa Dr. (ST211140140):

Asphalt pavement resurfacing, replace curb and gutter, sidewalk and driveway approaches where necessary, sodding (7-foot width of tree border area), and grading.

N. 72nd St. – W. Congress St. to W. Hampton Ave. (ST211140132):

Asphalt pavement resurfacing, replace curb and gutter, sidewalk and driveway approaches where necessary, sodding (9-foot width of tree border area), and grading.

3rd Aldermanic District

Alley between N. Bartlett Ave., E. Kenwood Blvd., E. Linnwood Ave., and N. Oakland Ave. (ST212150104):

Concrete alley pavement reconstruction, replace some abutting walk or driveway approaches, grading, and storm drainage facilities where necessary.

10th Aldermanic District

W. Wells St. – N. 45th Pl. to N. Hawley Rd. (Excluding Structure) (ST211150103):

Concrete pavement reconstruction, replace all curb and gutter, replace sidewalk and driveway approaches where necessary, narrow street from 50 feet to 48 feet, sodding (8-foot width of tree border area), and grading.

12th Aldermanic District

W. Walker St. – S. 2nd St. to S. 3rd St. (ST211150184):

Concrete pavement reconstruction, replace all curb and gutter, replace sidewalk and driveway approaches where necessary, narrow street from 46 feet to 36 feet, sodding (10 – 12-foot width of tree border area), and grading.

13th Aldermanic District

S. 2nd St. – W. Edgerton Ave. to a point 800 feet north of W. Vogel Ave. (ST211150106):

Asphalt pavement resurfacing, replace curb and gutter, sidewalk and driveway approaches where necessary, install new walk as necessary, sodding (7-foot width of tree border area), and grading.
