Re: Open File for Salary Adjustment


Dear Honorable Members:

I am writing this letter to request a salary adjustment for Inspector of Police Edward Liebrecht, who was promoted to Inspector of Police on July 30, 2006.

According to the 2006 Salary Ordinance, upon his promotion to Inspector of Police, Inspector of Police Liebrecht was placed at Salary Grade 12, Step 5 (\$3,075.97). Currently the highest paid subordinate to his position is a Deputy Inspector of Police, currently at Pay Range 842, Step 4 (\$3,324.11). I am respectfully requesting that Inspector of Police Liebrecht be placed at Step 8 of Salary Grade 12 (\$3,371.51).

The reason for this request is based on the fact that although a Deputy Inspector is in charge of the Milwaukee Police Department after regular duty hours, the Inspector of Police would be in charge of any major incident and/or crime scene. Therefore, I believe this salary adjustment will provide appropriate rank compensation for the required duties and responsibilities of the position of Inspector of Police.
