With the conversion of West State Street from one-way to two-way traffic, there is a need to remove the metered parking spots on the south side of West State Street between North 6<sup>th</sup> Street and North 7<sup>th</sup> Street. However, there is room to add metered parking spots on the north side of West State Street between North 6<sup>th</sup> Street and North 8<sup>th</sup> Street. This will result in an overall increase in the number of metered parking spaces available. Therefore, we are recommending the following changes:

The Removal of:

"Two-Hour Meter Parking, 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM Monday-Friday, Two-Hour Parking 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM Saturday." (South side of street)

The Installation of:

"Two-Hour Meter Parking, 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM Monday-Friday, Two-Hour Parking 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM Saturday, One dollar per hour." (North side of street)
