RE: Resolution relating to the historic designation for the Emily Parker Groom House at 1903 N. Cambridge Avenue, in the 3rd Aldermanic District.

An application was recently submitted to the Historic Preservation Commission to designate the Emily Parker Groom House at 1903 N. Cambridge Avenue as a historic site or structure (see map on back of this page).

A public hearing has been scheduled for Tuesday, December 11, 2012 at 3:00 p.m. in City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Room 301-B to determine whether or not the proposed designation of the Emily Parker Groom House at 1903 N. Cambridge Avenue satisfies the criteria for historic designation in accordance with Section 320-21 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.

If the Commission determines the building meets at least one criterion, a favorable recommendation for nomination can be forwarded to the Milwaukee Common Council.
