



This report is written by Police Officer Corstan D. COURT, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 06/12/19 at 12:14pm, Milwaukee Police, along with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation conducted a license premise check at 2108 W. Holt Avenue (Absolute Auto Salvage). There were several violation observed which included; City License not displayed, vehicles sold or brought that were not entered into a log book since 04/18/19, hours of operation was not posted on door, they were not checking for liens, they were not reporting to NMVTIS, there was no working video system, They were not taking a color copy of identification from customers who sold second hand auto parts, and they were accepting "Junk Bill of Sale" that was not properly filled out. Many of these violations were a repeat from the last time DOT conducted a license premise check (2017). The applicant and owner were uncooperative with the officers over their findings.

On 06/12/19, along with Department of Transportation (DOT) Jim BARTNIK, I conducted a license premise check at 2108 W Holt Av (Absolute Auto Salvage).

Both the agent and owners Efim BREHMAN and Ivanov TEM were on scene.

There were several Chapter 93 violations to include: city license not displayed, vehicles sold or bought not entered into Log book since 04/18/19, hours no posted on door, not checking for leins, not reporting to NMVTIS, no working video system, not take color copy of identification from customers who sold second hand auto parts, accepting Junk Bill of Sale that is no properly filled out.

Many of these violations we a repeat from the last time DOT conducted a check (2017). DENK has still not decided if the State will issue citations.

Since it is my first visit with this licensed premise I am giving a verbal warning. I will follow up with this business. It should be noted the owners were somewhat uncooperative because they did not want to discuss and accept all the violations that were found.

- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
