Dear Mr. Tsirlin:

This is to notify you that on Tuesday, April 16, 2013, the City's Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council that your Class "B" Tavern and Public Entertainment Premises licenses for the premises located at 4126 N. Teutonia Ave. ("Zarko's Nightclub") be renewed with the condition that the capacity be limited to 100 persons.

On April 19, 2013, you were mailed a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendations of the Licenses Committee with respect to the renewal applications for Class "B" Tavern and Public Entertainment Premises licenses in which the Committee recommended that the licenses be renewed with the condition that the capacity be limited to 100 persons. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of Tuesday, April 30, 2013, commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. At that date, time, and place, you did not appear, and you did not file written objections to the report of the Licenses Committee. You were not represented by counsel.

Following consideration of the report of the Licenses Committee, the Common Council granted to renew the Class "B" Tavern and Public Entertainment Premises licenses notwithstanding the recommendation of the Licenses Committee.


