File # 021184 is a resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of a Milwaukee Metropolitan Drug Enforcement Grant.

Background

- 1. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) to apply for, accept and fund a Milwaukee Metropolitan Drug Enforcement project from the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance through the Wisconsin Office of Justice Assistance.
- 2. This is a continuing grant.

Discussion

- 1. The purpose of the Milwaukee Metropolitan Drug Enforcement project is to reduce the volume of controlled substances in the Milwaukee area through the prevention and suppression of illegal drug activity.
- 2. This grant will fund the following existing positions:
 - 2 Police Officers
- 3. Three Office Assistant II positions, previously funded through this grant, will no longer be funded by this source.
- 4. This grant encompasses the period of January 1, 2003 through December 31, 2003.

Fiscal Impact

- 1. The total amount of this grant is \$202,835 with \$103,354 provided by the grantor and \$99,481 provided by the city.
- 2. The city portion of the grant is included in the 2003 MPD operations budget.
