REASON FOR REQUEST:

Jeffrey Cullen, a City of Milwaukee police officer, was in the scope of his employment and operating a City of Milwaukee vehicle that was traveling southbound on North 35th Street. As the City vehicle entered the intersection of West Capitol Drive and North 35th Street, the uninsured motorist, who was proceeding westbound on West Capitol Drive, failed to yield the right-of-way by disregarding the red traffic light, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Cullen sustained injuries to his head, neck, low back, left shoulder, right knee, and left eye. The treating physician indicated the neck and shoulder injuries are permanent. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$108,557.25.
