

On Saturday, August 26, 2017, I was assigned to work the Wisconsin WINS Youth Tobacco Initiative, checking area vendors for age compliance tobacco purchases. Assisting in this assignment was Destiny Yarbrough, (B/F, 04/02/00), of 1938 N. 20th Street. YARBROUGH is 17 years of age which is not of legal age to purchase tobacco.

At approximately 9:45am, YARBROUGH entered Vince's Beer and Liquor at 7141 N 43rd Street and purchased 1-pk of 2/\$.99 Swisher Sweets cigars. YARBROUGH stated the cashier/clerk described as an older W/M, balding, wearing a gray shirt did ask her (YARBROUGH) for her ID and after she (YARBROUGH) told him she didn't have one the clerk sold the Swisher Sweets to her anyway. I entered the store and immediately identified the cashier based on the description given. The cashier identified himself as Patrick J. TANNHAUSER (W/M, 03/05/63). TANNHAUSER did remember YARBROUGH and did admit to selling YARBROUGH Swisher Sweet cigars. TANNHAUSE was advised that I would be sending out a letter to enroll in the M.A.R.T.S. program.



On 5-23-18 at 3:00PM I conducted a CPTED survey at 7507 W. Oklahoma Av. I met with Mr. Enicacio Sanchez-Mora who is the pending owner of Buena Vista Banquet Hall. A Mr. Leonardo Sanchez was also at the location who is the pending manager of the business.

Mr. Sanchez-Mora stated he is in the process of purchasing the property which will be used as a Banquet Hall. The sale of the property is dependent on the approval of a liquor license. Mr. Sanchez-Mora stated the Hall would be open for events only. He stated they plan on hosting family type of events such as weddings, baptisms, anniversaries etc. He stated there may be live bands or DJ's for these events but would not be hosting strictly live band or DJ style music events.

During the walk through I observed four interior security cameras. Mr. Sanchez-Mora stated the cameras are not in working order. He stated they have plans on updating the security system but was unsure how many cameras or what type of system they would have.


