# Milwaukee Employment/ Renovation Initiative (MERI)

- \$1 million grant from State Dept. of Financial Institutions
- Use: Renovate tax-foreclosed properties
  - 6 developers/must purchase at least 5 houses
  - Houses sold for \$1
  - Maximum grant: \$10,000 (State grant requirement)
  - Renovation grant awarded after work is completed
  - Buyers must employ workers with barriers to employment
  - Grant amount depends on hours worked





#### RPP work hours performed



- Worker sources
  - Milwaukee Builds
  - Youth Build
  - Employ Milwaukee
  - House of Correction
  - WRTP
  - Mindful Staffing
  - Housing Authority
- Avg. work hours/house
  - 332 hours
- Avg. grant: \$9,500

#### What's next

- Grant expenditure deadline: December 2018
- All construction completed by November 2018
- Anticipate not all of grant will be awarded to selected buyers
  - One buyer did not purchase number of houses requested
  - Only two houses sold from "incentive reserve" to date
  - Average grant is less than \$10,000
- Plan to add houses renovated and sold through City's lease-to-own program
