LEASE AGREEMENT EXTENSION BETWEEN THE CITYOF MILWAUKEE AND MILWAUKEE COUNTY FEDERATED LIBRARY SYSTEM

This Lease Extension Agreement dated this ___ of ___ 2007, is by and between the Board of Trustees, Milwaukee Public Library (hereinafter referred to as the "LESSOR"), and the Milwaukee County Federated Library System (hereinafter referred to as the "LESSEE").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, The LESSOR entered into a lease agreement (hereinafter referred to as the "Original Lease") with the LESSEE on January 1, 1994 and Lease Extensions on May 22, 1997, May 17, 2000; and February 5, 2006; and

WHEREAS, The LESSOR and the LESSEE are agreeable to extending the current lease agreement by two years and to increasing the lease payment to \$119,250 in 2008 and \$122,000 in 2009;

NOW, THEREFORE, both parties agree as follows:

- All the terms and conditions of the Original Lease, a copy of which is attached hereto, are incorporated herein by reference, and excepting as hereinafter modified, shall continue to remain in full force and effect between the parties.
- The LESSEE has complied with all of said conditions as stated in the Original Lease, and the parties have agreed to the following contract extension terms:
 - The Original Lease, amended in February 2006, shall be extended until December 31, 2009.
 - B. The LESSEE agrees to pay the LESSOR for rental the sum of \$119,250 in 2008 and \$122,000 in 2009.
