MILWAUKEE COUNTY

Federal trial delayed for real estate broker

The federal kickback trial of a Brookfield real estate agent has been delayed again as the defendant's attorney moves to bring in a parade of current and former state officials, including Attorney General J.B. Van Hollen, in an effort to show the prosecution was politically motivated.

Larry Lupton is charged with soliciting a \$75,000 kickback in connection with the proposed sale of a \$30 million state office building in Madison.

He is charged with committing federal bribery and wire fraud as well as lying to the FBI.

Lupton's trial had been set to begin Sept. 22, but instead U.S. District Judge Lynn Adelman will hear from several witnesses on that day to decide if they will be able to testify at the trial.

Besides Van Hollen, Lupton's attorney, Joseph F. Owens, promises to subpoena state Sens. Fred Risser (D-Madison) and Ted Kanavas (R-Brookfield), former Administration Secretary Marc Marotta and others.

Owens contends his client was following accepted real estate industry practices and wasn't breaking the law. Owens lost an effort to have an expert witness who would have testified to that allowed into

the trial.

He took the issue to the 7th Circuit Court of Appeals, which upheld Adelman's ruling.

Milwaukee man killed in gunfight outside bar



A 32-year-old Milwaukee man was killed in an exchange of gunfire Saturday in front of the Jamaican Inn, police Capt. Timothy Burkee said Sunday.

A 39-year-old Milwaukee man is recovering from a non-life-threatening gunshot wound, Burkee said.

The man is in police custody, Burkee said.

The two men have a history of disputes, Burkee said.

A dispute began inside the Jamaican Inn at N. 30th St. and W. Atkinson Ave., and then spilled out in front of the bar. Police were called to the area at 11:35 p.m.

The death is the city's 50th homicide this year.

At this time last year, there were 67 homicides, Burkee said.

Police identify girl stabbed with tool

A 15-year-old Milwaukee girl stabbed in the head with a screwdriver during an after-school fight has been identified as Liliana Razo, police Capt. Timothy Burkee said Sunday.

Razo remained in critical condition at Children's

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Hospital of Wisconsin in Wauwatosa, he said.

An 18-year-old Milwaukee man is in custody, and police are seeking a 19-year-old man, Burkee said.

The incident started when two groups of people got into an altercation Friday outside South Division High School, 1515 W. Lapham Blvd. School security staff broke it up, police said, but the groups met again near S. 13th and W. Rogers streets, where the stabbing occurred.

Man wearing 'Scream' mask robs video store

Cudahy - A man armed with a semiautomatic handgun and wearing a mask like one in the movie "Scream" robbed Super Video II in Cudahy on Sunday, police said.

The man demanded cash from an employee and fled with the money from the store in the 5000 block of S. Pennsylvania Ave. The robbery occurred just before 2:30 a.m., police said.

WAUKESHA COUNTY

Pewaukee considers \$7 million in projects

City of Pewaukee - Significant residential, commercial and industrial growth in the city over the past three years is prompting the city to consider about \$7 million in water utility projects to meet future demand.

Construction of a new water tower in the Ridgeview Corporate Park and a new water main along Fatima

Drive as well as drilling two shallow wells likely will be paid for by water utility users and by fees paid by those who connect to the water system.

Public Works Director Jeffrey Weigel said the \$7 million in work would not be necessary if the city tapped into the village of Pewaukee's water system.

But for that to occur, the municipalities would have to consolidate or, short of that, agree to merge their water utilities. Several years ago, the village rejected a utility merger, Weigel said.

Talks about merging the municipalities have been renewed, and city officials directed Weigel to see whether the village would be open to a utility merger.

Ald. Steve Bierce also asked Weigel to look into whether the city's water utility could be merged with Waukesha's.


Man gets probation for exposing himself

Waukesha - A 37-year-old New Berlin man has been sentenced to two years of probation after he was convicted of two misdemeanor counts of exposing himself through photos sent by mobile telephones to a 17-year-old girl.

Daniel C. Zens had been charged in February with exhibition of child pornography, possession of child pornography and exposing a child to harmful material, all felonies, according to a criminal complaint filed in Waukesha County Circuit Court.


But the charges were changed to misdemeanors, and Zens pleaded guilty Friday and was sentenced by Judge Lee S. Dreyfus Jr.

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The facts in the case did not support the felony charges, officials said.

Water tower house to be open for viewing

Waukesha - A water tower that was converted into a home next to Waukesha Memorial Hospital will be open for viewing Saturday.

The 5,500-square-foot, three-bedroom, four-bath home has striking architectural features including a ceiling height of 37 feet. The tower, which was originally designed to hold 675,000 gallons of water in the Fourth Street Water Reservoir, was built on the highest point in the city.

A \$5 donation will benefit the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department K-9 unit. One of the department's retired dogs will be at the open house after 1 p.m. Proceeds from the fund-raiser, planned by the Citizens Academy Alumni, will go toward safety equipment or other needs of the unit.

The Volkswagen rolled over. The driver was taken to Froedtert Hospital and her daughter was taken to Children's Hospital of Wisconsin, both in Wauwatosa, he said. The five people in the Galant were taken to Columbia-St. Mary's Hospital Ozaukee in Mequon, he said.

The Sheriff's Department declined to release the girl's name.

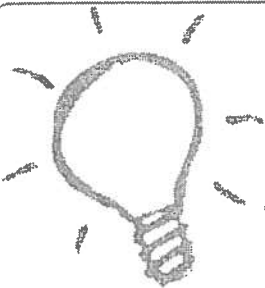
The sheriff's marine unit and the state Department of Natural Resources' airplane located the teens three-quarters of a mile east of the city's water treatment plant.

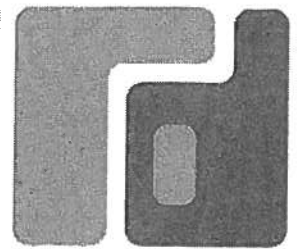
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
