This incident involved a foot chase.

The MPD initiated a criminal investigation in which the officers initially declined to give a statement without counsel. When they requested counsel, IAD compelled POs Campbell, Lough, Warren and Kaul to give statements concerning the incident after issuing PI-21s. The DA reviewed the matter and did not issue charges against the officers. Attached is a copy of the DA's letter and an itemization of the time and services rendered.
