Our traffic engineering staff has investigated this request and found that motorists exiting the parking lot of the Griffin's Hub Dealership on the south side of West Parnell Avenue have a difficult time seeing traffic traveling east and west bound on West Parnell Avenue when vehicles park close to the dealership driveway. Therefore, in the interest of public safety, we recommend installing these restrictions to increase sight visibility.

We will prepare the necessary legislation for the next Public Safety Committee meeting, so that you may support it to final passage.
