PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE A WISCONSIN POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION
SYSTEM (WPDES) PERMIT No. WI-0062723-01-0

Facility Where Discharge Occurs: DRS Power & Control Technologies, Inc., 4265 N 30th St., Milwaukee

Receiving Water And Location: Lincoln Creek east of 35th Street, Milwaukee County

Brief Facility Description: DRS discharges cooling water from heat exchangers and air conditioning units. An individual permit is being issued because a discharge from a cooling tower with biocide addition is being removed from the sanitary sewer and will discharge to the storm sewer.

The Department has tentatively decided that the above specified WPDES permit should be issued for this new discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on or object to the proposed permit action, or to request a public hearing, may write to the Department of Natural Resources at the above named permit drafter's address. All comments or suggestions received no later than 30 days after the publication date of this public notice will be considered along with other information on file in making a final decision regarding the permit. Where designated as a reviewable surface water discharge permit, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency is allowed up to 90 days to submit comments or objections regarding this permit determination.

A public informational hearing may be held if response to this notice indicates significant public interest pursuant to s. 283.49, Stats., or if a petition requesting a hearing is received from 5 or more persons. Requests for a public informational hearing shall state the following: the name and address of the person(s) requesting the hearing; the interest in the proposed permit of the person(s) requesting the hearing; the reasons for the request; and the issues proposed to be considered at the hearing.

Information on file for this permit action, including the draft permit and fact sheet (if required), may be inspected and copied at the above named permit drafter/basin engineer's office, Monday through Friday (except holidays), between 9:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Please call the permit drafter/basin engineer for directions to the office location, if necessary. Information on this permit action may also be obtained by calling the permit drafter at (414) 263-8623 or by writing to the Department. Reasonable costs (usually 20 cents per page) will be charged for copies of information in the file other than the public notice and fact sheet.
