This report is written by Police Officer Corstan D. COURT, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 09/13/2020 at 1:44am officers were dispatched to a Shotspotter call at 2307 N: 40<sup>th</sup> St. Responding officers observed a large crowd in front of Premier Sports Lounge, 4001 W. North Av, and located 3 vehicles parked in front that were struck by gunfire. The officers spoke with Deandre HARRIS who stated he was the owner of the business. HARRIS stated the business was closed and the officers could not enter. He did allow them inside but refused to show them the surveillance video.

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2. On 10/12/20 at 11:30am, A call in meeting was held at the Third District Police Station with the applicant of 4001 W. North Avenue and members of the Milwaukee Police Department. During the meeting it was discussed how there was no cooperation between her employees and police, who wanted to obtain video surveillance, during a shots fired investigation. The applicant said the reports were incorrect and that all contacts would be documented. She also said that in the future she has no problem allowing police to view her cameras.

3. On 11/05/20 at 5:00pm, A person walked into the Third District Police Station to report a false imprisonment/armed robbery complaint which began at 4001 W. North Avenue. Investigation revealed that on 11/01/20 at 1:00am a subject was drinking at the tavern and later being in a vehicle with three females. The females drove the subject throughout the city punching, stabbing, pistol whipping, and making her withdrawal money from an ATM. The subject was able to escape, flag down Milwaukee Police and received medical treatment.

4. On 03/07/21 at 1:09am, Milwaukee Police, along with the health department, conducted a license premise check at 4001 W. North Avenue. Upon arrival, officers and the health department workers attempted to open the front door but it was locked and a female answered the door by barely opening it not allowing anyone to see inside. The health department employee stated why they were there and the female closed the door and locked it without letting anyone inside. Officers then heard a female get on a microphone and tell patrons inside to "put on their masks" and the owner to talk with police. The front door was then unlocked and the applicant was reluctant to let officers and the health department inside. After the applicant allowed police and the health department inside, they saw a lot of people inside the establishment and most were not wearing masks and social distancing. Officers also observed what appeared to be more people inside the location then capacity allows (80 persons). After leaving the location the health department officials said that they would be issuing citations totaling around \$12,000.00.
5. On 05/27/21 at 1:09am, Milwaukee Police observed a large fight in front of 4001 W. North Avenue. Approximately 20 people were actively fighting, including tavern staff, which required 15 squads to disperse the crowd. After the crowd was dispersed, officers conducted a license premise check and found that most of the staff was uncooperative and argumentative regarding their investigation. The manager could not provide officers with any license information and there were no licenses posted. Investigation into the fight revealed that the manager had struck a female inside the establishment and the fight spilled out into the street. While talking outside with the victim/witness, multiple staff exited the business and began to fight with the victim a second time and the manager battered the victim a second time. The manager was arrested.
6. On 09/11/21 at 8:24pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 4001 W. North Avenue. Staff voiced an issue with the police department taking their security equipment on a different issue and requested that police keep driving around the area during tavern hours to keep vehicles secure and safe.

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7. On 11/02/21 at 11:42pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 4001 W. North Avenue. When walking up to the tavern, officers observed approximately 70 vehicles surrounding a 1 block radius of the establishment and patrons were parking in a vacant field northeast of the tavern. The security guard/DJ refused to answer questions regarding the capacity and initially ignored officers when told to turn down the music and instruct patrons to exit the front door for a capacity check. The applicant approached officers and was reluctant to let officer in the establishment and said she was not over capacity because her capacity is 180 patrons (LIRA has the tavern capacity at 80 patrons). The manager of the tavern attempted to close the front door on officers and was uncooperative with the investigation. Officers, using a hand-held counter, counted 86 total persons inside the establishment (this does not include the patrons who were seen by officers exiting through a back hallway). Officers interviewed a patron who stated the tavern was allowing people in the upstairs private residence and back patio. The applicant was issued a citation.

8. On 11/09/21 at 2:15pm, Milwaukee Police, along with an Assistant District Attorney, held a meeting with the building owner of 4001 W. North Avenue. The meeting was in regards to the tavern, located on the first floor of the building, was allowing patrons into the apartment above the establishment. The owner stated that his wife is the applicant of the tavern and that they do not allow patrons upstairs which is a vacant apartment.
9. On 11/10/21 at 10:24pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 4001 W. North Avenue. When officers approached the front door, the security guard physically stop the door from opening and told officers that they could not enter. The security guard did eventually let officers in but was argumentative on why the police were there. The owner of the building was given a citation for the incident in Item #7 and when officers were retrieving his information, he told officers that he lives above the establishment. It should be noted that he told officers and an Assistant District Attorney in Item #8 that the upstairs is vacant.
10. On 11/14/21 at 3:48am, Milwaukee Police received a 911 call stating that a subject was shot at 4001 W. North Avenue but was currently at a different location. Investigation revealed that the subject was shot outside after leaving the tavern. During the investigation, the applicant and owner were uncooperative and argumentative with police and it is unknown if any argument or altercation stemmed from inside the tavern.
11. On 12/29/21 at 12:28am, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 4001 W. North Avenue. During the check, officers observed two females being escorted out by security who were yelling about something that happen inside the tavern. Security told police that the argument started inside the tavern and asked police to have the females removed from the property. Both females walked away from the property when asked by police.
12. On 06/17/22 at 12:55am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 4001 W. North Avenue for a battery complaint. Investigation revealed that one of the security guards' uncle punched her in the face because she was kicking him out of the tavern for arguing with his girlfriend. The battery occurred outside and the uncle was issued a citation. Officers interviewed the owner who said the altercation had nothing to do with the tavern and was upset police were inside the establishment. He showed officers his current licenses, which were inside a drawer behind the bar and had expired licenses displayed behind the bar. The owner was told to display his updated licenses.
13. On 07/01/22 at 1:35am, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 4001 W. North Avenue. Officers interviewed the owner and asked if they could see where he keeps all his alcohol and the boxes they came in. The owner said all the alcohol he purchased is on the shelf and he buys by the bottle from Badger Distributing.
14. On 10/08/22 at 2:00am, Milwaukee Police, while on patrol, observed a male lying in the street, bleeding from the head, in the 4000 block of W. North Avenue. A large crowd leaving the tavern at 4001 W. North Avenue were stating that the male was assaulted due to an incident that happen inside the tavern. The staff of the tavern locked the doors and refused to speak to officers regarding the incident.
15. On 10/09/22 at 12:59am, Milwaukee Police conducted a capacity check at 4001 W. North Avenue. Security was uncooperative with police and they had to find the owner in order to get cooperation from the employees. Police counted 75 patrons and employees which is in compliance with their capacity of 80.

This report is written by P.O. Ajay ALVAREZ, assigned to District 3, late power shift.

On Tuesday, November 2, 2021 at 11:42 PM Squad 3466 (P.O. Joseph BINTER and I), Squad 3431 (P.O. Jesus MERCED and P.O. Samuel KEHOSS), Squad 3490 (P.O. Nathaniel PETERSEN and P.O. Jaimee WARNER) and squad 3412 (Sgt. KINGSTON) conducted a tavern check on Premier Sports Lounge located at 4001 W. North Ave. due to the amount of cars parked outside the bar as well as the amount of people entering the bar. It should be noted that the city street parking was completely full and patrons were parking in a vacant field northeast of the tavern. An approximate count of 70 vehicle were observed in the surrounding 1 block radius of the premise.

As we approached the bar you could hear music coming from inside the bar. A female security guard, later identified as Wanda D. KIMBLE (b/f, 8-5-79), opened the door. KIMBLE was multi tasking as a DJ for the music inside of the tavern. KIMBLE refused to answer questions regarding the capacity of the premise and stated she did not know. KIMBLE initially ignored officers when told turn off the music and instruct the patrons to exit from the front door for a capacity check. KIMBLE was ignoring officers and continuing to DJ. KIMBLE eventually complied after several requests.

The owner of the premise, Tabitha A. HARRIS (b/f, 11-13-74), eventually came to the front door, but was reluctant to let officers in. HARRIS stated that she did not think the premise

was over capacity. HARRIS then stated that the premise's capacity is 180 people. An additional employee came to the front door and stated that he was the manager. The male was uncooperative and attempted to close the front door on officers, while officers were standing in the doorway. The male stated that the premise had a capacity of 100 and was not over. The male was later identified as Deandre D. HARRIS (b/m, 11-2-75). Deandre D. HARRIS was observed to be heavily intoxicated.

After majority of the patrons exited the premise officers began to enter the premise and finish checking. As officers were entering, approximately 20 people were seen leaving the main bar and walking into a back hallway. I observed the back hallway lead to a locked door of a private residence. It should be noted that the private residence is located directly above the premise.

The rear patio was also checked and did not reveal any additional patrons. P.O. BINTER concluded the count with a count of 86 total persons. It should be noted that the individuals seen leaving through the back hallway were not able to be counted and were not a part of the final total count.

Through the Lira system Premier Sports Lounge has a capacity of 80. The entire investigation was recorded via officer's body worn Axon cameras. P.O. BINTER used a hand held clicker to count the patrons.

P.O. MERCED spoke to a female patron outside of the premise. The female stated the bar was holding a birthday party. The female stated that the bar was allowing people upstairs in the private residence and the back patio.

HARRIS was issued a contact card with my information on it.

HARRIS was issued a citation (Citation #M580XS5WWT) for over capacity totaling \$1,313 (\$313 for the first person and \$200 for every person after).

It should be noted, all officers were in full duty uniform and the meeting was conducted in the conference room of District 3. Additionally, ADA Francisco MINEO attended the meeting.

Harris arrived to the front lobby of District 3 regarding an owner letter sent to him regarding activity at Premier Lounge on November 2nd, 2021 and patrons going upstairs to an unidentified apartment in the building.

Harris stated the upstairs is off limits to patrons who visit Premier Lounge. HARRIS stated last week on Tuesday, November 2nd, 2021 he was throwing a birthday party for himself and the people from the lounge were not allowed access upstairs. I asked HARRIS what is the upstairs portion of the bar and he stated it was a 2 bedroom apartment. HARRIS stated no one lives up there and it's vacant. HARRIS stated on Tuesday, November 2nd, 2021 no patron went upstairs and said something along the lines of, "That wasn't the case."

HARRIS informed us that the upstairs apartment unit is either 4001 (A) W. North Avenue or 4003 W North Avenue, however he could not remember what was on the paperwork.

HARRIS stated he is the owner of the building and his wife is the licensee of Premier Lounge. HARRIS stated if he or his wife isn't on scene then the bar is closed. HARRIS stated he doesn't have a manager who runs the business.

This concludes my report.

This report is written by P.O. Kurt KEMNITZ, assigned to District 3, Late Power Shift.

On November 10, 2021 at approximately 10:24pm, Squad 3465, P.O. WARNER and I, initiated a tavern check of Premier Sport bar located at 4001 W North Ave.

The reason we were at the location was to issue a citation to the licensee of the establishment for overcapacity violation which occurred on a previous date.

Upon approaching the front door of the location the security guard, later identified as Wanda D KIMBLE (b/f, 05/05/1979) was standing outside of the location. When I attempted to open the front door of the location, **KIMBLE physically stopped the door from opening by putting her hand out and holding the door and verbally stated that we couldn't enter the building without her permission.** KIMBLE did let us in however once inside was argumentative on why we were there and that they don't need us there.

The Citation was given to Deandre HARRIS (m/b, 11/02/1975) who identified himself as the owner. HARRIS also provided me with the licenses for the business which were on the wall behind the bar as well as their occupancy placard. While retrieving HARRIS' information, **HARRIS stated that he lived above the bar. This is not accurate information due to the building owner stating that the upstairs is vacant.** It should be noted the night of the overcapacity incident Officers observed approximately 20 individuals go from the bar to the upper unit through a connecting stairwell.

On 11/14/2021 at 3:48 pm MPD received a 911 call for a subject that was shot and stated that it happened at Premier Sports Bar however she was at a different location at the time of the call.

Squads responded to the female's location as well as the area of Premier Sports Lounge (4001 w north Ave). During the investigation I located 6 casings on the side walk to the west of 3935 W North Ave. While securing the scene with crime scene tape I heard voices from inside Premier Sports Bar. It should be noted that it was after 4am when I heard these voices and the business appeared closed with all the lights off and door locked. Upon knocking the licensee Tabitha HARRIS answered the door and allowed squads in to review possible video and investigate establishments possible involvement in the shooting since the victim stated it occurred at Premier Sports Bar. HARRIS was accompanied by her husband and fellow owner of the business Deandre HARRIS as well as two other patrons/ friends of the couple. During our investigation and questioning of the event all parties denied knowing of any incident and were uncooperative and argumentative with police. Due to an incident in 2020 police detectives subpoenaed and logged into evidence the video recording system from the establishment. Since that subpoena occurred the bar has not had any recordings to assist in our investigations. It is unknown if any argument or altercation stemmed from inside the business or not. The four parties were interviewed by detectives and it was determined that the incident happened outside of the establishment after the female departed the establishment.

I observed two of the males to be wearing shirts that said "Security" on the back in big white letters. I immediately heard the females yelling about something that happened inside the tavern, but could not make out what exactly they were saying. We observed Security handle the problem for a little while until the 2 females tried to push past security to get back into the tavern.

At this time I requested another squad to come assist us as we went to make sure that nothing escalated further. Squad 3451 (PO's Devin Whitfield and Daniel GOODCHILD), Squad 3412 (Sgt. William KINGSTON), and Squad 3390 (PO Isaac KING) came to assist us. I made contact with one of the security guards who identified himself as Antonio M. CURLEE (b/m, 4-1-83). CURLEE stated the problem started inside the bar with an argument between the two females. CURLEE stated both females were asked to leave and escorted outside of the tavern. CURLEE stated the females would not be allowed back into the bar and asked us to have the females removed from the property.

I made contact with one of the females who was upset that she did not get "food and a bottle" she paid for. CURLEE stated the female's card was denied and that she would not be getting the food and bottle. Both females walked off and away from the bar with no further issues when they were told to leave by police.

On Friday, June 17, 2022, my partner (P.O. Tyler HEANEY) and I responded to assist Squad 3330 (P.O. Lauren MAROWSKY and P.O. Thomas WRIGHT) with Battery investigation at the intersection of N. 40th St. and W. North Ave.

As squad 3330 arrived, they observed the security guard to Premier Sports Lounge, located at 4001 W. North Ave. in the middle of the street yelling. The security guard was later identified as Wanda D. KIMBLE (b/f 8-5-1979). She told officers that she was struck by her uncle inside the bar. When asked who it was, her uncle, later identified as Alfred D. BELL (b/m 11-22-1973) walked out of the bar. KIMBLE attempted to attack BELL upon seeing him by swinging her arms with a closed fist. Due to her aggressive behavior, officers had to place KIMBLE in handcuffs for the duration of the investigation.

KIMBLE stated that while working inside the bar, she observed BELL arguing with his girlfriend. She approached BELL and told him that he was not going to do that in here and kicked him out the bar. Both KIMBLE and BELL left the bar, which is when he grabbed KIMBLE by the shirt and punched her with a closed fist in the face 1 time causing pain. BELL was issued a citation for Battery.

During the interview of BELL and KIMBLE, an unknown black male who identified himself as security to Premier Sports Lounge were very problematic during the investigation. He kept yelling at KIMBLE asking why did she call the police and that the police need to leave. Officers heard the unknown black male state multiple times he was going to beat his ass, referring to to BELL. He kept interfering with P.O. WRIGHT's investigation multiple times even after being asked to leave and was causing a big disturbance on scene. When officers attempted to obtain his name, he became very uncooperative refusing to provide the information but then had random citizens answer for him. He eventually gave name of Drew L. JONES (b/m 9-2-1984), which did not come back on DOT or Tri-tech.

I went inside to speak with the manager who identified himself as Deandre D. HARRIS (b/m 11-2-1975). While speaking with officers he stated that the incident that took place outside had nothing to do with his bar and was very upset that we were inside his bar. HARRIS provided the following licenses to officers. Premier Sports Lounge had the following licenses, Class B Tavern, Food Dealer, and Public Entertainment. All licenses had a expiration date of 12/17/22. HARRIS kept the licenses in a red folder that was in a drawer behind the bar, while expired licenses were displayed behind the bar. HARRIS was advised that the updated licenses needed to be displayed. The bartender working the shift was identified as Vanessa L. MOORE (b/f 9-19-1994) who showed me a Class D Operator's License, which expires on 12/31/23.

## LICENSE PREMISE INSPECTION

Due to having prior knowledge that in the past the employees of Premier Sports Lounge have people go to the second story of the building, which is a private residence so they would be under capacity. Squad 3440 went in first to conduct follow-up. As soon squad 3440 entered Premier Sports Lounge, P.O. GOODCHILD and P.O. MARX blocked the access to second story stairway.

I positioned our marked Milwaukee Police Squad on N. 40th St. facing southbound with our Axon squad camera activated and captured the east wall and rear exit door of the establishment.

I activated my Axon Body worn camera and approached the front door of the business. As the door open to Premier Sports Lounge, I asked the security to see their counter. The security guard at the door looked around and appeared to stall for time. The security guard at no time during our investigation presented a counter to me.

I notified the security we will be conducting a capacity check and the patrons needed to exit the front door of the business. Security advised me that I needed to speak with the owner/manager however at no point did he speak with me.

P.O. MAROWSKY counted the number of patrons as they exited both out loud for her body camera as well as on a handheld clicker. Premier Sports Lounge has a total capacity of 80 patrons, which include their employees. After approximately 30-35 individuals exited Premier Sports Lounge, the owner/manager still never came to speak with me and the DJ turn the music back on and the patrons still inside were refusing to leave. The security was not helping and kept stating I needed to speak with the owner but would not go get him.

I decided to locate the owner/manager myself and located him by the rear of the bar near the kitchen door. I spoke with Deandre D. HARRIS (b/m 11-2-1975) and advised him that a capacity check was being conducted and everyone needed to leave. HARRIS had the DJ turn down the music and asked everyone to leave the establishment. Once all the patrons exited Premier Sports Lounge, P.O. MAROWSKY counted the employees for a total of 75 patrons and employees.
