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

The Prohibited Dangerous Animal Appeal Hearing was held on July 19, 2018 at 9am at the City of Milwaukee Lake Tower office. Present were Mark Dembowski, Danielle - Pitrof, Kathleen Pilarski, Roxana Herrera, Reme Bashi, Atty. Michael Verrilli, Atty. Jay Unora, DNS officials and the three member hearing panel.

After testimony was received by all respective parties, the panel went into committee and rendered a decision declaring your dogs, Diamond & Buzz, to be a prohibited dangerous animals. Based on that decision, the order from the Department of Neighborhood Services stands.

You are ordered to euthanize your dogs, Diamond & Buzz, within seven days or permanently remove your animals from the City of Milwaukee.

If the animals are taken outside the city, you must provide the inspector with the full name, address and phone number of the person where the dogs are proposed to reside. The City of Milwaukee will contact that municipality to determine if the animals will be accepted.

Failure on your part to comply with this order may cause the issuance of a citation which may result in a forfeiture ranging from \$150 to \$1,000 for each day of violations, disobedience, omission, neglect or refusal. In accordance with Chapter 200 Milwaukee Code, a re-inspection fee may be charged for any re-inspection, except no fee shall be charged for the final re-inspection when compliance is recorded. Re-inspection fees shall be a lien upon the real estate where the re-inspections were made.



Remarks: This supplement report was written by PO Randy BRUSO, district 6, day shift. On Saturday, 04-28-18 at about 11:30 AM, the victim (HERRERA) stop at district 6 and informed me she had information on the possible owner of the dogs that killed her pet. HERRERA stated sometime between 9-11 AM, on 04-18-18 she talked to the postal worker who delivers her mail and he stated he observed the attack and recognized the attacking dogs and stated they lived somewhere nearby. He stated when he had the address, he would contact her again. HERRERA stated on 04-27-18 the postal worker gave her the address of 1422 W. Clayton Crest Ave as the address of where the owner and the dogs lived. HERRERA stated the postal worker wished to remain anonymous. On 04-28-18 at 12:28 PM, went to that address and talked to Carolyn J. HOGAN. HOGAN stated she is the owner of 2 dogs. One a "Great Pyrenees" mix that is a white colored female and about 5 years old The other is a "Boxer/Rotweiler" mix that is a brown colored male and about 7 years old. HOGAN stated she wasn't home the day and time the incident occurred and also stated her dogs never go out without her. I observed her yard to be well fenced. HOGAN did say she has a roommate named Mark F. DEMBOWSKI. She stated he might of accidently let the dogs out but he never told her about it. HOGAN gave me his information. The description she gave me of DEMBOWSKI and the vehicle he drives matches what was given to me by the victim and the witness in the original report. HOGAN was sympathetic and cooperated fully during my questioning. On Sunday, 04-29-18 at about 1:47 PM, I called DEMBOWSKI by phone and he agreed to meet me Tuesday, 05-01-18 and tell me what happened. I also stopped and talked to HOGAN and she stated when she asked DEMBOWSKI about the incident the previous day (via tex messages), he admitted the dogs got loose from him and he retrieved them by the condos the next block over (which would be the victims residence). On Tuesday, 05-01-18 at 8:41 AM, I talked to DEMBOWSKI in person at the 1422 W. Clayton Crest Av address. He stated on the date of the incident, both dogs were in the enclosed driveway. He stated he went inside to use the bathroom and when he came back out, the dogs were gone and the front gate was open. He stated he sent looking for both dogs in is vehicle and was told there were two dogs loose at the condominiums (5525 S. 13th St.) He stated he saw two people in that driveway and one of them pointed towards north (#G). DEMBOWSKI stated he called for the female (white dog) and she came running right away. He stated he had to physically put the brown dog into his vehicle. He stated he thought the dog had a "toy" in it's mouth. He stated he drove back home, passing the victim and the other female without stopping. He stated the reason he didn't stop or tell HOGAN about the incident was he was afraid and knew HOGAN would be very upset.
