1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):  
This is an annual grant renewal for funds from the Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) that support MHDs Sexual and Reproductive Health Program located at the Keenan Health Center. Specifically, these funds support five Disease Intervention Specialist staff and one Health Program Assistant salaries to perform disease surveillance and investigation for sexually transmitted infections. Additional program funds support staff training, lab and clinical supplies, consultant fees, and mileage reimbursement. All funds enable MHD to conduct HIV and other sexually transmitted infections (STI) investigations in Milwaukee to ensure adequate treatment and follow-up.
2. Relationship to City-Wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:  
Education, testing, and treating clients is a key strategy in addressing STIs, which are a major factor in Milwaukee's population health and other health outcomes. Milwaukee continues to be a city with high rates of STIs, and there are inequities in incidence, prevalence, and access to affordable and responsive testing and care. These funds assure access and capacity to testing and treatment, as well as education and engagement to understand and reduce key risks for the spread of STIs and adverse health consequences.
3. Need for Grant Funds and Impact on Other Departmental Operations (Applies only to Programs):  
These grant funds complement City funding and other State grants to sustain accessible, high quality sexual and reproductive health services for Milwaukee residents. Funding provides a meaningful amount of the total funding for the Keenan Health Center clinic.
