
INFORMATION ABOUT COSTS INCURRED BECAUSE OF CITY SEWER FAULT

On December 20, 2000 Reupert Plumbing came to 3715 N. 40th St. to investigate an intermittent slow draining basement toilet. They determined that the problem was due to slow sewer draining outside of the basement. They performed a drain clean-out out past the middle of the street (about 55 ft.). There was not much evidence of blockage.

The problem really did not go away and the intermittent problem became more severe. Now there was sewage coming up through the drain in the basement. Reupert Plumbing returned on January 3, 2001. They did a cleaning routine from the drain to the clean-out where they had done the previous cleaning. They returned the next day with their larger equipment and cleaned from the east wall clean-out some 75 ft. There was no good result ore evidence of blockage. At that point they informed me that I needed to contact the city. At 7:40 A.M. I called 286-3427 and talked to Rick who said that someone would be right there. Some 20 minutes later a city inspection vehicle came to our address and Al, the driver, said that they were aware of a blockage at the intersection of Nash and 40th St. His crew took care of the problem, the toilet flushes properly and there has been no more problem with sewage and the basement drain.

Al told me that the fault never was due to my house plumbing but rather was a fault due to the city's sewage system. He gave me the document titled "Instructions for Filing A Claim Against the City of Milwaukee". On the back of this letter please find a copy of the bill paid to Reupert Plumbing for \$182.65. I understand that this is the amount to which I am entitled.
