265.15 RECORDS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC (WILEAG 10.2.1)

- A. There is strong statutory presumption in favor of the right of the public to inspect records in the custody of a public authority. Wis. Stat. § 19.35(1)(a).
 - The current version of the Wisconsin Department of Justice Public Records Law Compliance Outline, the Police Open Records Legal Advisor, and/or the assistant city attorney Office of the City Attorney will be consulted regarding questions on handling public records requests.

265.25 REQUEST FOR RECORDS FROM PUBLIC

B. The public may submit verbal requests for copies of, or access to, records during regular office hours between 7:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., Monday, Wednesday, and Friday, holidays excluded as posted on the department's website at the Open Records counter located at 2333 N. 49th Street 2nd Floor (Open Records counter is closed on Tuesdays and Thursdays).
